OUTCOMES OF COUNTER FRAUD INVESTIGATIONS

Summary

To inform Members of progress in investigating allegations of housing and council tax benefit fraud and other non-benefit fraud. This report covers activity during the first three quarters of 2011/12, ending 31 December 2011.

1. Budget and Policy Framework

1.1 Following the Council's decision to establish this committee, it is within the remit of this committee to take decisions regarding accounts and audit issues.

2. Background

- 2.1 Medway Council has had a sanction policy since 2002 (revised in 2006) following changes to the way benefit investigations should be conducted. These changes resulted in a more rigorous investigative standard being adopted which lead to specific outcomes, known as sanctions. Namely, that local authorities should consider the use of one of the following courses of action following a successful investigation:-
 - Prosecution
 - Issue of a caution
 - Issue of an administrative penalty (fine).

3. Outcomes of Investigations

- 3.1 In the first nine months of 2011/2012 financial year, the investigations team has identified £951,000 of fraudulent overpayments, comprising £535,000 Housing and Council Tax Benefit and £416,000 of Department for Work and Pensions (DWP) paid benefits.
- In the nine months to 31 December 2011, there were 25 successful prosecutions, 12 Administrative Penalties and 9 Cautions for benefit offences. Of the 25 successful prosecutions, two await sentencing and three have resulted in imprisonment. A further four have resulted in suspended custodial sentences.

All these cases are detailed at Annex A, with the first two quarters presented as reported previously to Audit Committee, and the third quarter reported for the first time.

3.3 The following table shows the progress of current cases following a decision to prosecute.

Note: these are joint investigations and many of these cases are passed to DWP Prosecution Division (PD) by DWP FIS (Fraud Investigation Service). Consequently, it is FIS that receives communications from PD. Therefore, Medway Council does not hold precise dates to analyse these cases.
