#### Summary

#### 3. Agenda planning meeting

- 3.1 Members will be aware that Overview and Scrutiny Committees hold agenda planning meetings on a regular basis. These give officers greater guidance on information Members wish them to provide when scrutinising an issue. An agenda planning meeting was held on 19 January 2010.
- 3.2 At this meeting officers informed Members that the LAA monitoring scheduled for the February meeting has been deferred until the next meeting in March to ensure all performance data from partners has been scrutinised by the relevant LSP theme partnership and Members are given the most up to date information on actions planned to ensure the targets are met.
- 3.3 It was also noted that discussion by Cabinet and Business Support Overview and Scrutiny committee on the Single Equality Scheme had

been deferred to allow further public and stakeholder consultation on the scheme. Similarly, the annual equalities report has been deferred as it should be considered alongside the single equality scheme. However, progress on the council's equality and diversity objectives and commitments will be reported in the quarter 3 council plan monitoring report, which will be considered by this Committee on 16 March.

#### 4.1 <u>Cabinet's Forward Plan</u>

There are no new items which have been added to the Forward Plan since the last meeting of this Committee, which are not already on the work programme or have already been considered.

# 5. The co-ordinating role of the Business Support Overview and Scrutiny Committee

  - pre-budget scrutiny
  - consideration of petitions presented at Full Council
  - consideration of called-in Cabinet decisions
