

PETITIONS – SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION

This supplementary table details petitions received and responded to at Full Council on 18 June 2009 which have inadvertently been omitted from the report.

Subject of petition	Council Date Presented by	Response
Save the Tudor Wall and garden – rescinding planning permission for part of the site	Councillor Haydock	Judicial review proceedings have been issued and the Council awaits to hear from the courts whether this will proceed. An approach has been made for the Secretary of State to issue a listed building enforcement notice to enable restoration of the partially demolished wall. The Council is also proposing to commission its own scientific test to clarify the age of the wall.
Concern at safety of low level of pavement at bottom of Magpie Hall Road and ask for improvements	Councillor Maple	The footway has been inspected on both sides of the road and apart from a few minor defects these are in sound condition. An order has been placed to repair a five metre length of kerbing that has been damaged. Although the kerb fluctuates in height there is a well-defined line between the road and pavement and no other works are intended to be carried out.
Concern at road safety on Waterloo Road. Ask for additional safety measures including reduced speed limit to 20 mph.	Councillor Griffiths	Recorded injury accident data has been checked which shows no personal injury accidents between 1 January 2006 and 31 December 2008. However, a traffic survey will be carried out so that intelligence-led enforcement can be undertaken if there is a speeding issue.
Request for resident only parking at Foord St, St Peter's St, Church St. and James St. Rochester	Councillor Bowler	The petition has been added to the ward file and parking review of the Rochester East ward.
Request to update the children's play area at Wigmore Park	Councillor O'Brien	Officers recently met with ward members and two residents and a refurbishment scheme was proposed and funding has been secured. The work is expected to be completed before the start of the school holidays.
Request for lighting in New Cut Alley, Brompton	Councillor Esterson	Officers have liaised with Councillor Esterson and funding has been secured for the lighting scheme and this will be implemented shortly.
