### **Disabled person applications**

The Partnership will continue to check Building Regulation applications for disabled person adaptations without a fee as required by the Building Act & Building (Prescribed Fees) Regulations

### Approved Inspector Register

The partnership will maintain and update the Approved Inspector Register for the public's information

### **Enforcement**

The Partnership will enforce the Building Regulations within the terms of the enforcement concordat. It will also receive and action notices from Approved Inspectors who are unable to gain compliance with the Building Regulations. This will include the dealing with unauthonsed work and informing Planning.

#### Competent Person Schemes

The Partnership will receive and process all competent person notices submitted to the authorities as required under the Building Act

Safety at Sport Grounds (duty requirement for Gillingham Football Club and Ebbsfleet Football Club).

The partnership will act as the 'Building Authority', as defined under the Safety at Sports Grounds Act, and will attend all meetings, safety inspections and live audits.

Provide a service in relation to demolition applications, as defined under Sections 80, 81 and 82 of the Building Act 1984.




