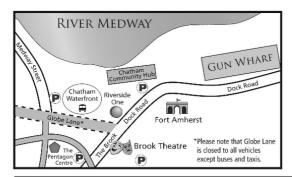

Purpose: At a previous meeting, Members asked if Ward level

crime statistics could be expanded to include five-

year trend analysis.

With regard to crime statistics, there have been some amendments to the Home Office counting rules, which make a 5-year direct comparison difficult.

As a result of the Governments Comprehensive Spending Review, Kent Police have been through a process of restructuring, which means there is unfortunately no analytical capacity to produce any 5-year data.
