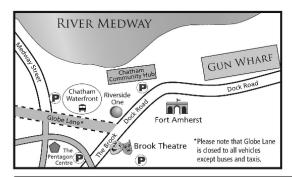

Summary description of the proposed change

- What is the change to policy/service/new project is being proposed?

As part of the Alternative Provision (AP) Review it recommends that the Local Authority should look at a restructure of all non-independent Alternative Provision in Medway, establishing an all-through integrated AP service on a single site.

To achieve this, the proposal results in a merger between the two state funded AP's in Medway, Will Adams (Local Authority Maintained) and The Rowans an Academy under the Inspiring Change Trust.

The merger will result on the technical closure of Will Adams and the expansion of The Rowans.

Initially the merger may not be possible to locate on a single site and so the two current sites will continue, i.e. the new single provision will operate over split sites until such time as it is possible to co-locate.
