
Members attention is drawn to paragraph 3.3 of the report on page 13 of the main agenda where there is an error. The position at Option C in the table should be 6th not 3rd. For clarification, the benchmarking reported in the Private Hire and Taxi Monthly magazine (PHTM) is based on a 2-mile journey. The difference between tariff Options B and C would only increase on journeys with significant mileage, i.e. airport runs.

The August publication of the PHTM was received on 3 August and shows significant changes to the benchmarking as a large number of Local Authorities have had a recent change in their tariffs. Therefore, attached as new Appendix D is the benchmarking table as at August 2022 with the current tariffs and a table projecting Medway's position for each of the proposed options. Again, Members should note that position for Options B and C are the same for the reasons specified above.
