Representation

Following the application being deferred by Members of the Planning Committee on 14 December 2022, the (applicant's) agent has responded to the deferral of the application as follow:

"Good afternoon, Amanda,

It was disappointing to see the application deferred at committee last night particularly when the red line issue does not fundamentally affect the proposed development in any way and requires no amendments to the development as proposed.

Reptile surveys were undertaken in a sub-optimal period in October when Reptile Surveys can be undertaken as per the guidelines. The surveys were not undertaken during a period or no surveying. As such KCC ecology have advised that 'a precautionary mitigation approach is produced and secured via condition with any granted planning permission'. Therefore, we do not need to undertake any further Reptile Surveys when a survey undertaken during a valid surveying period did not find any reptiles. If necessary, as has been agreed on other applications, if any additional reptile surveys are required to validated the results of the existing reptile survey then this can be conditioned to any permission issued to ensure that the relevant reptile mitigation is adequate.

I am unaware of any access issues. The site can be safely accessed with appropriate visibility splays and produces a very low level of traffic.

Based on the above I cannot accept the PEA below.
