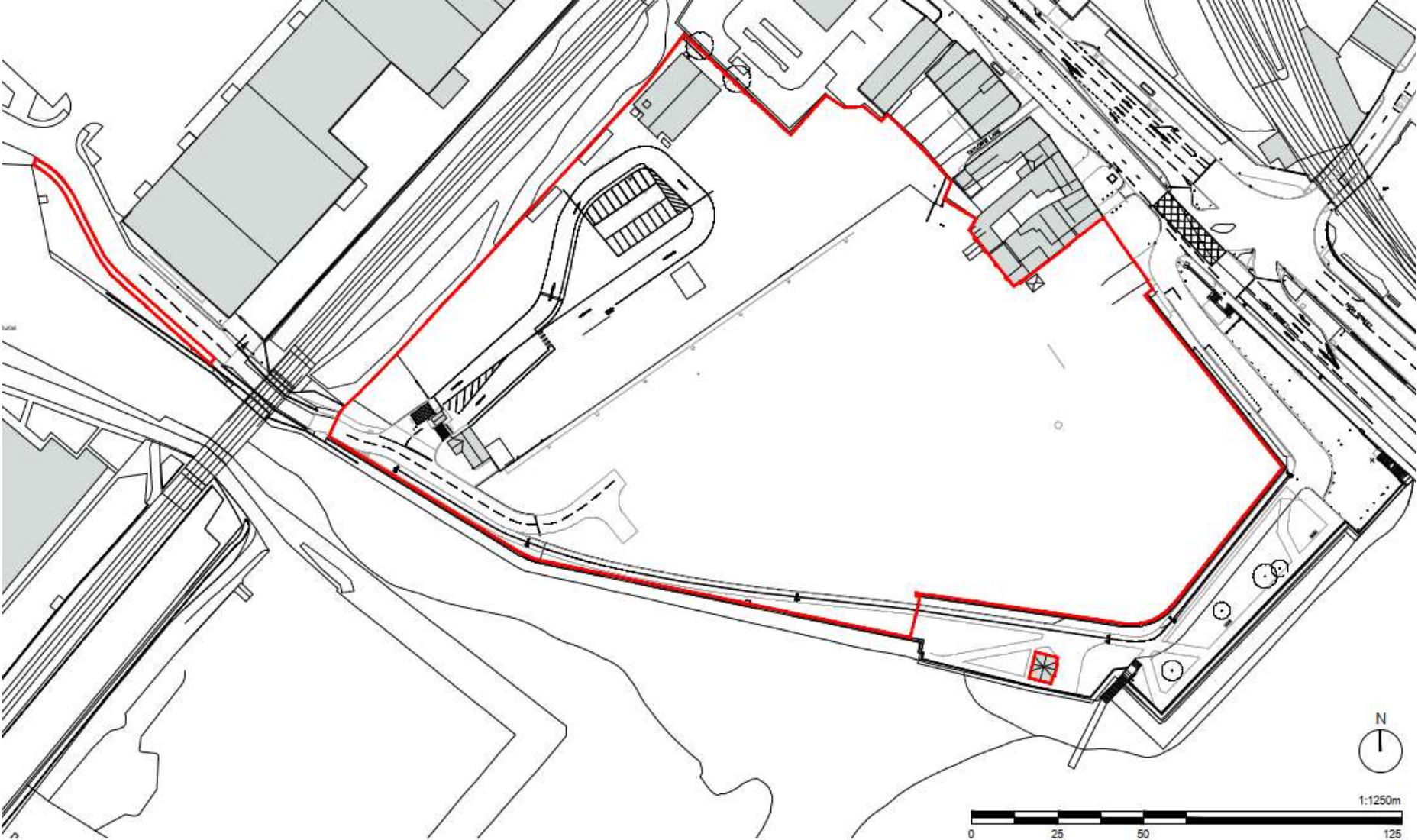

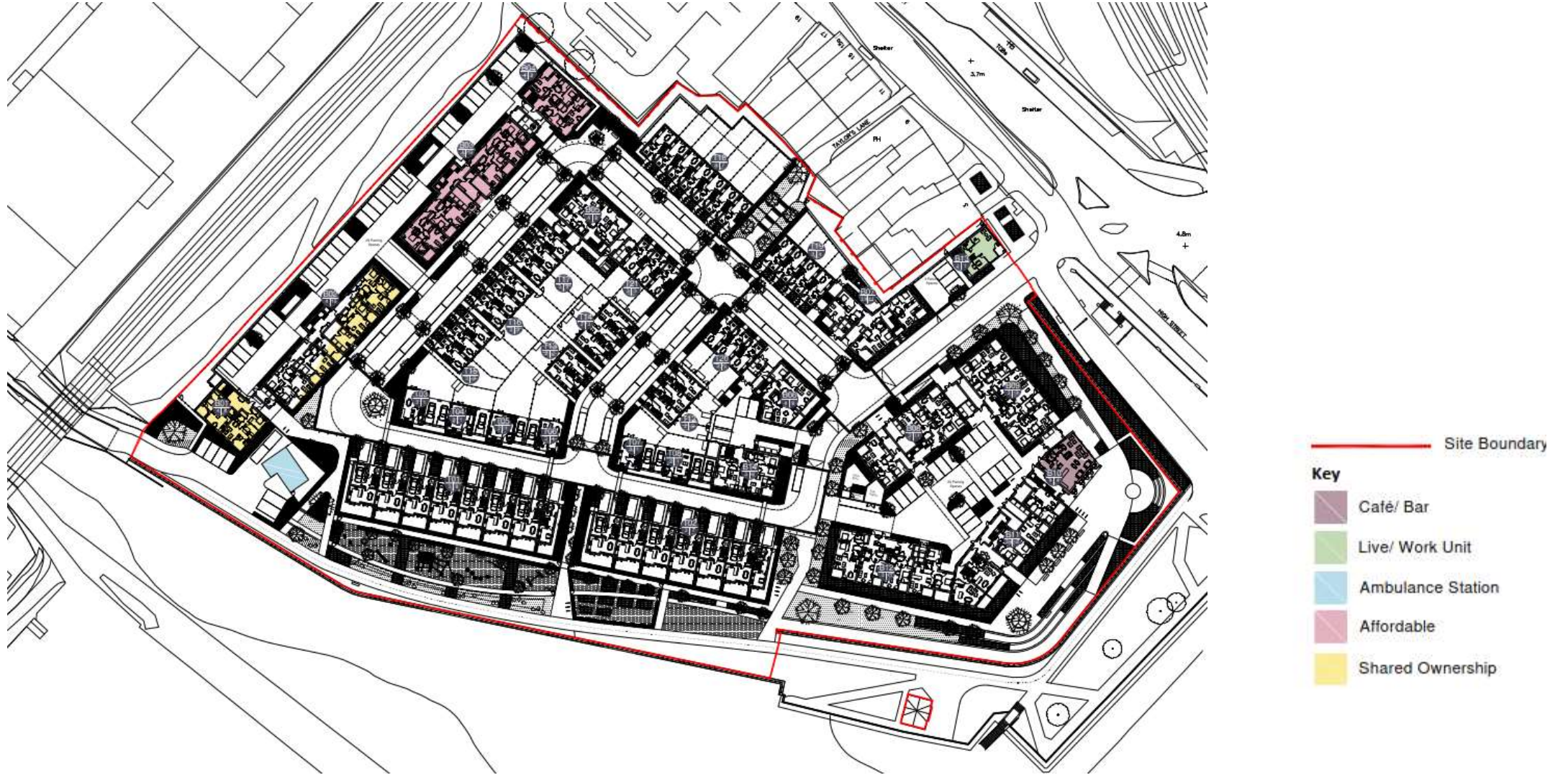

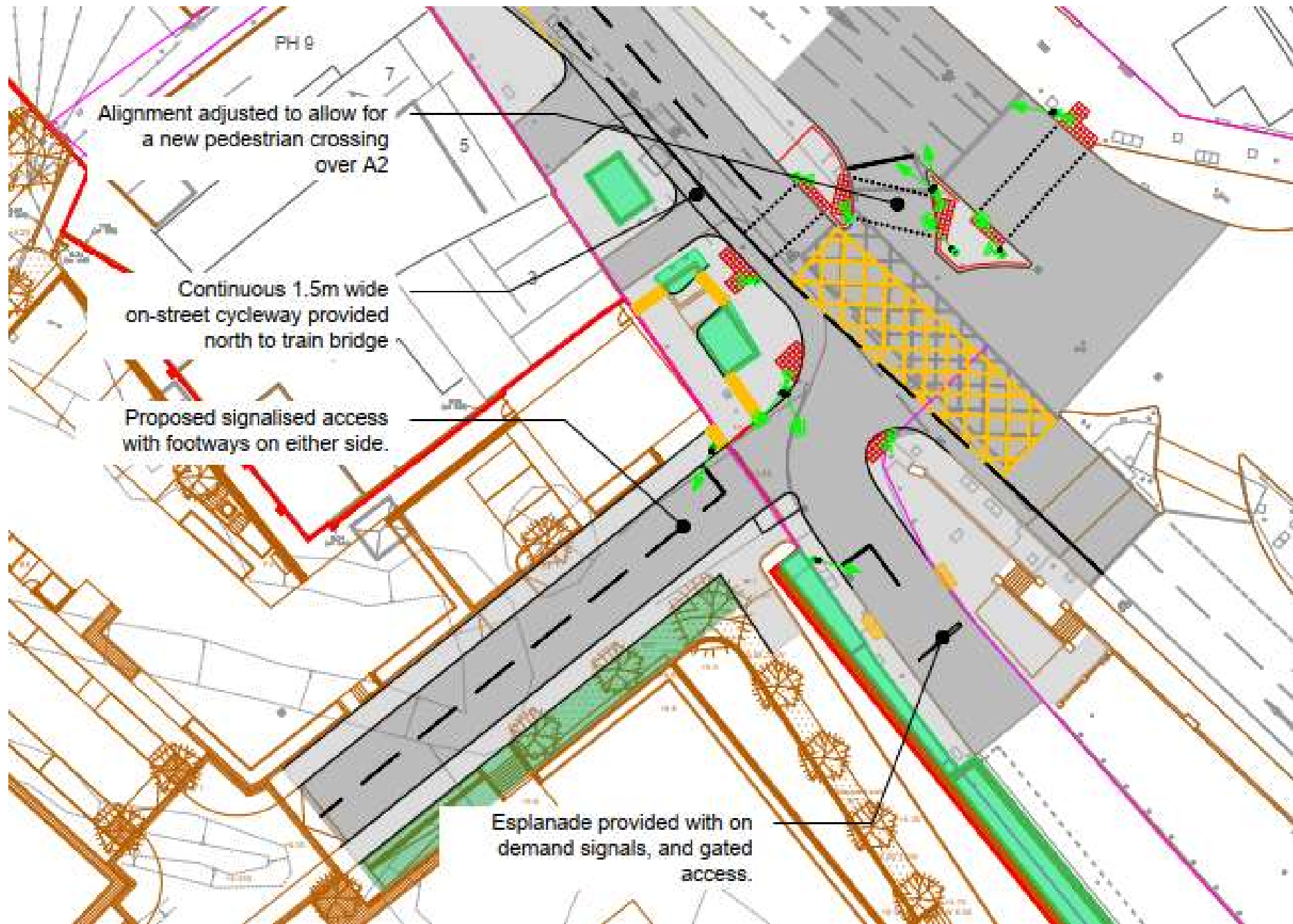

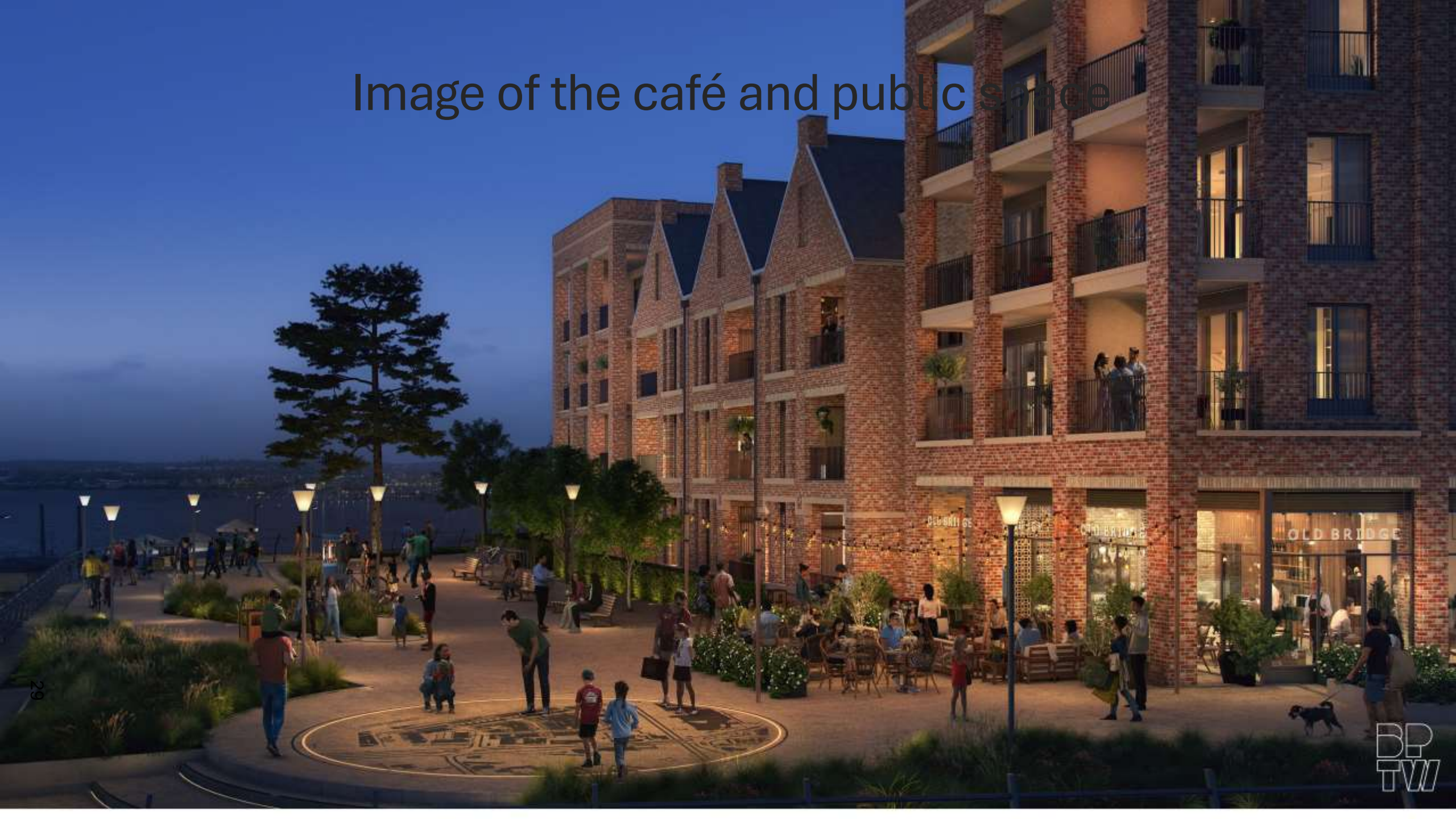

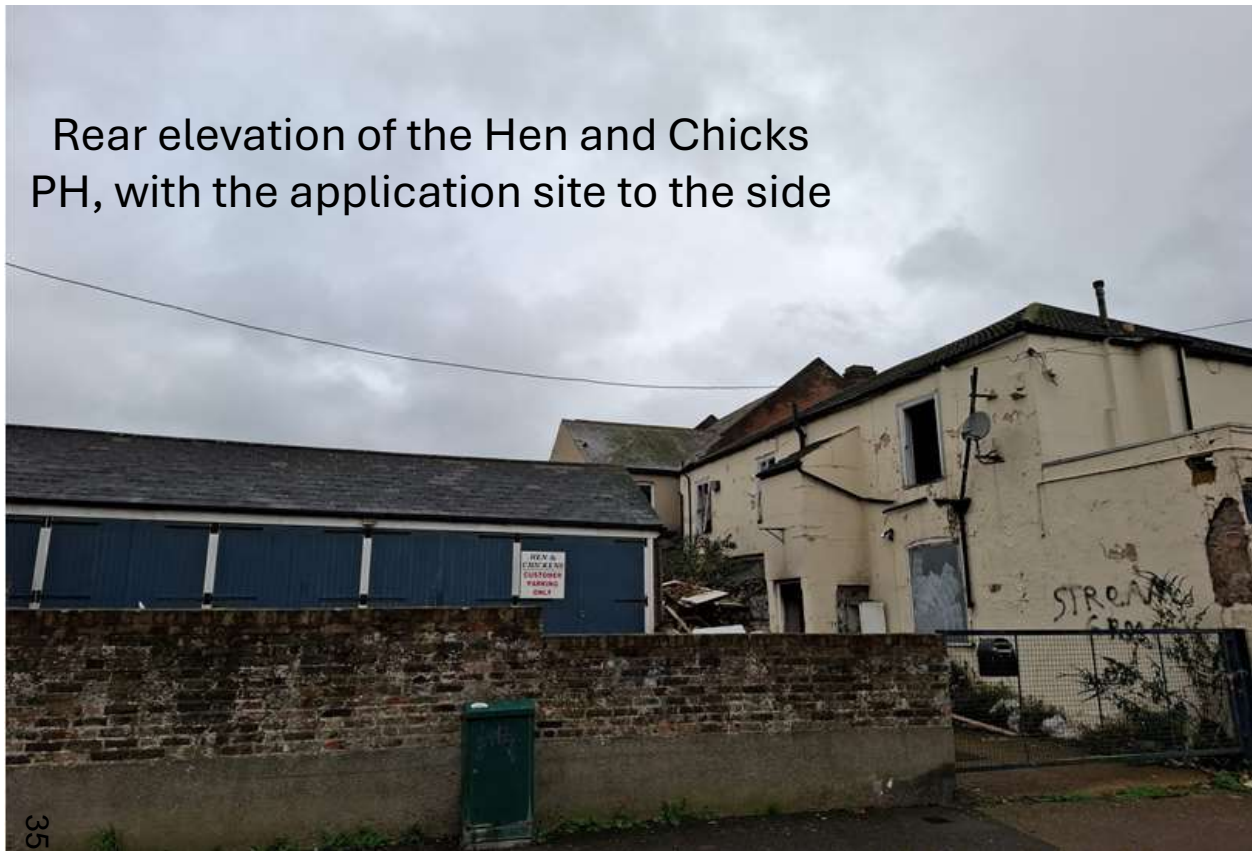

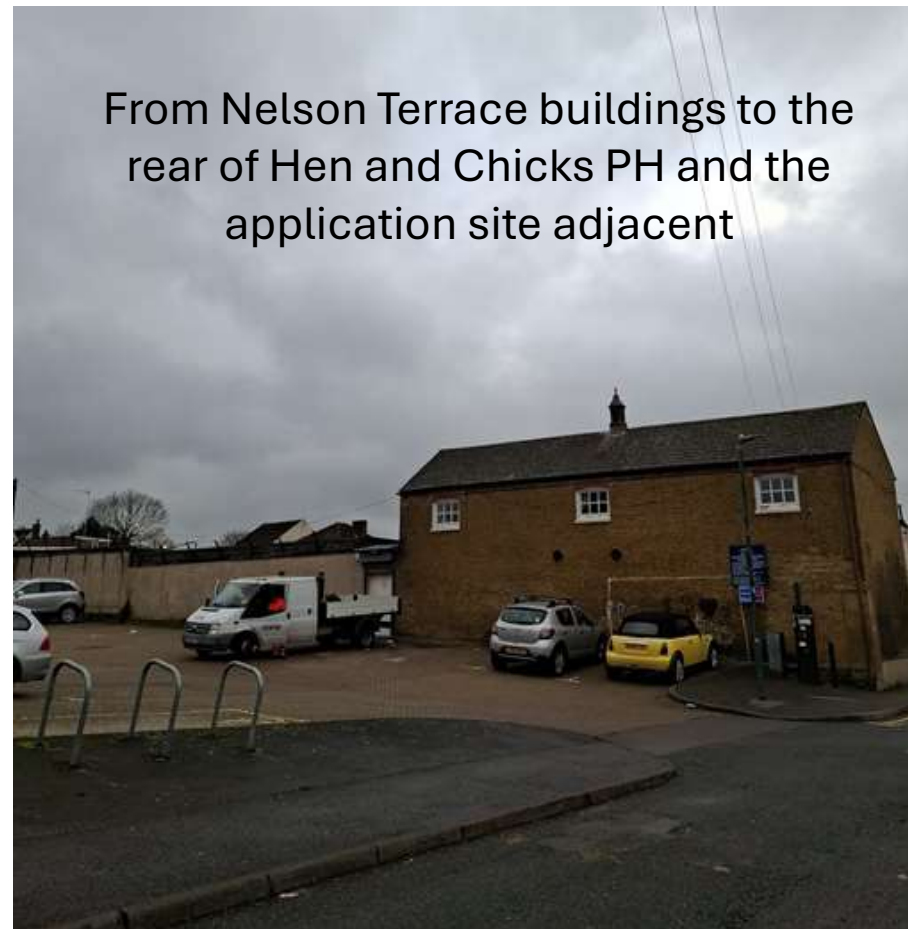

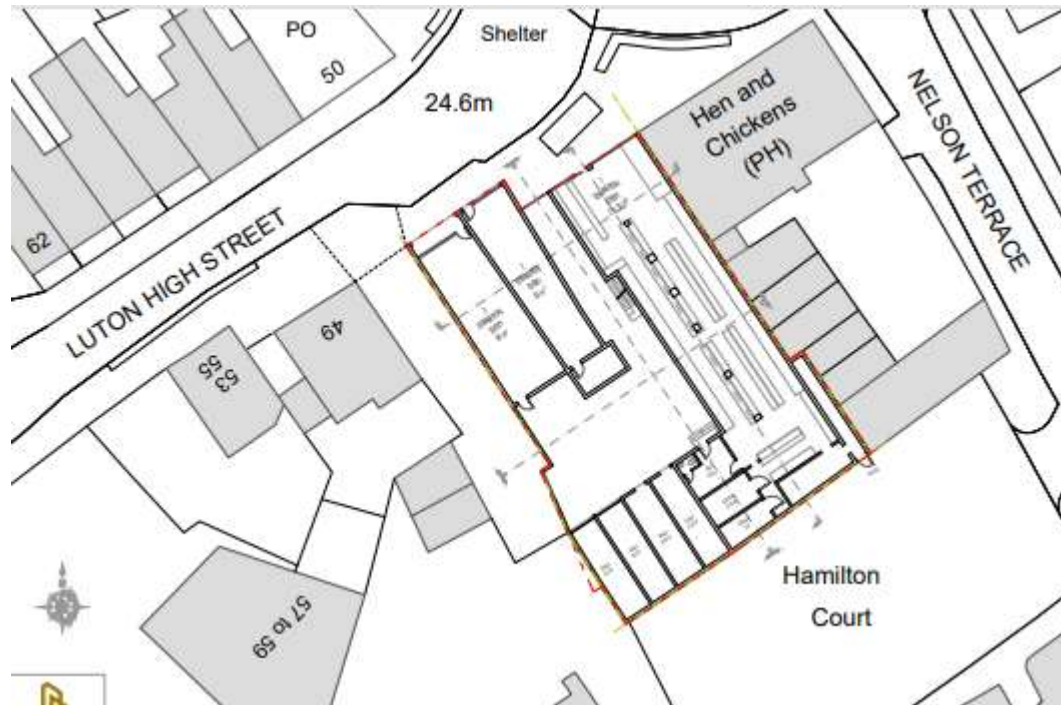

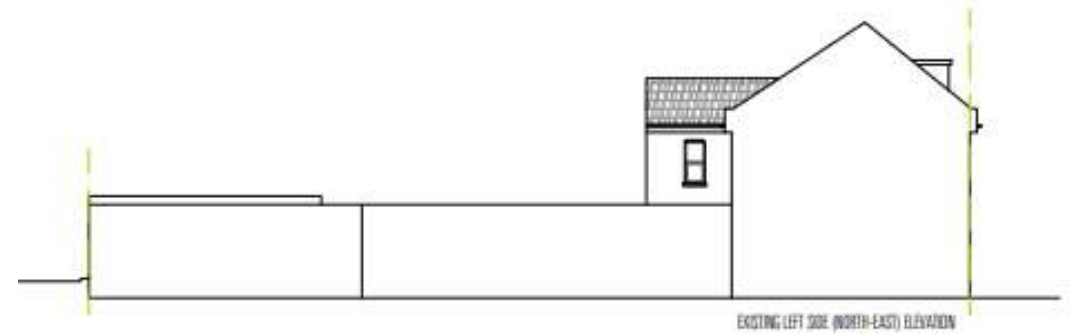
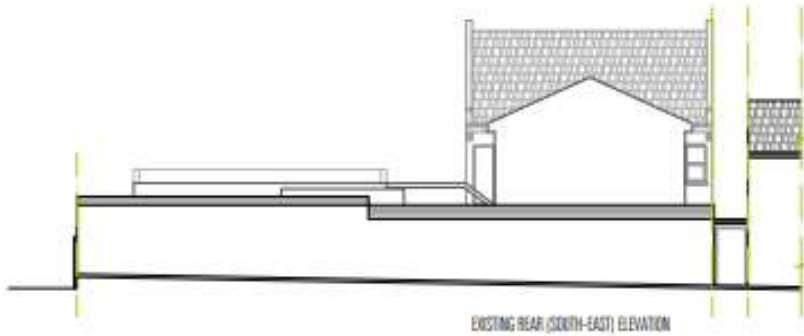
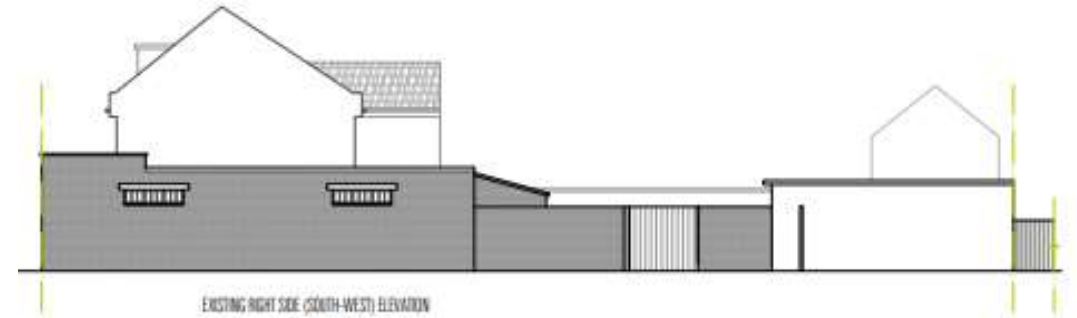


Existing ground, first and second floor layouts

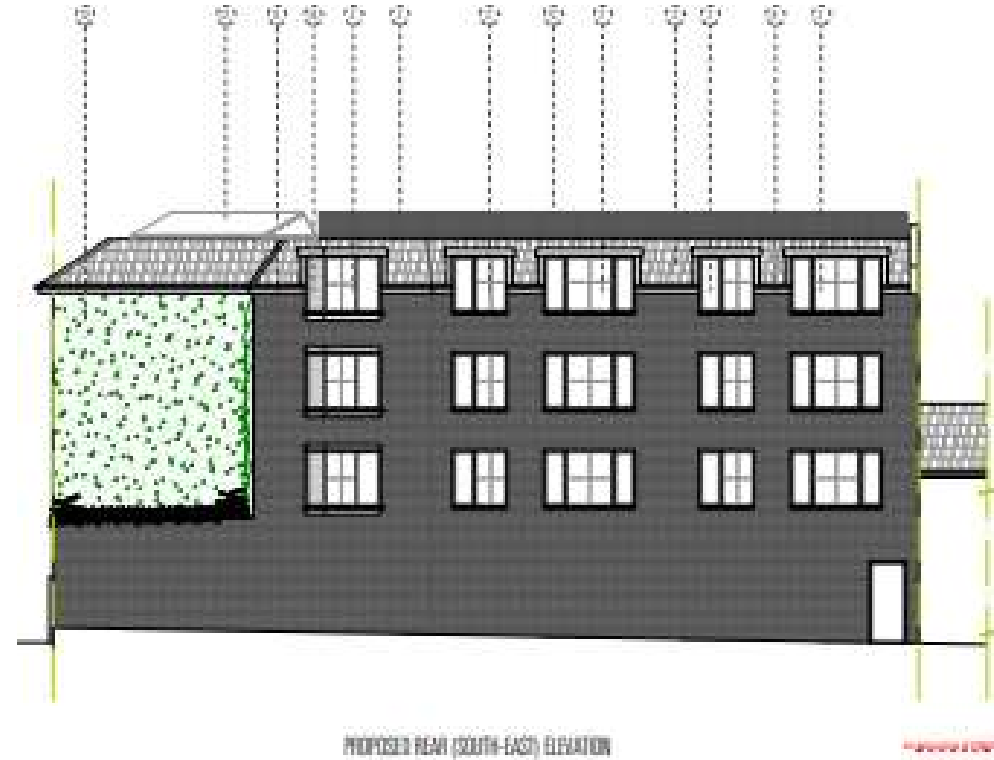


Proposed front and rear elevations

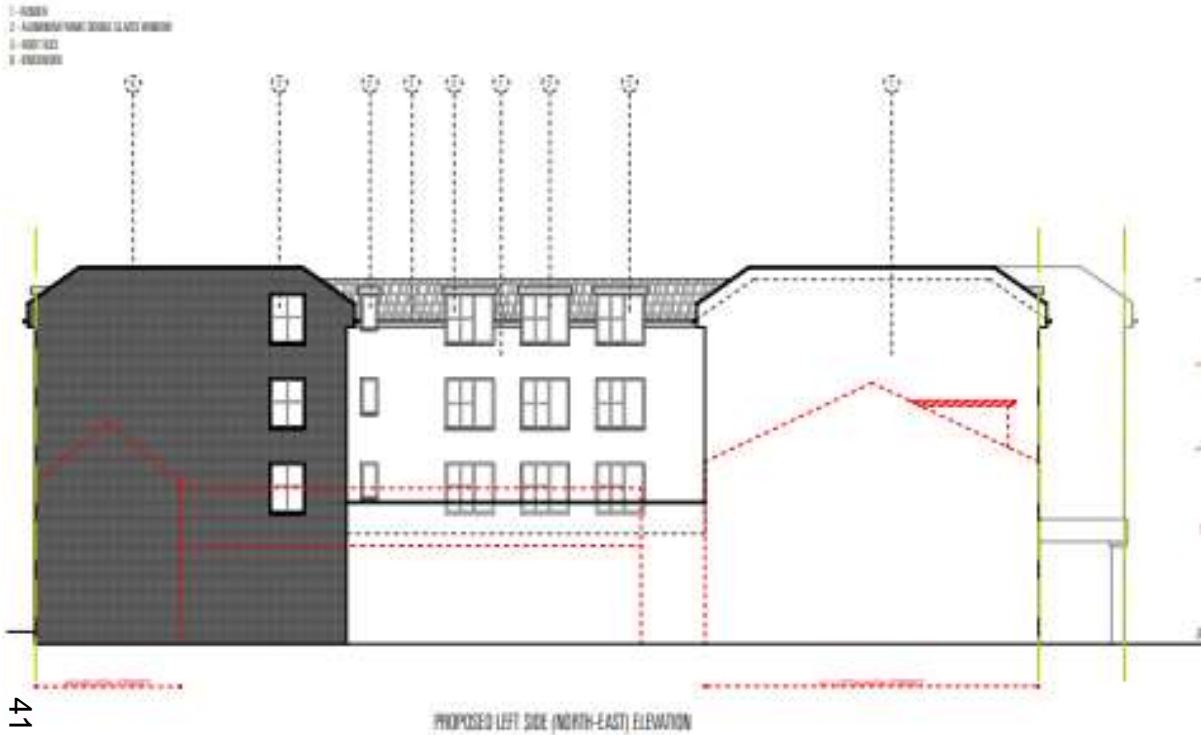

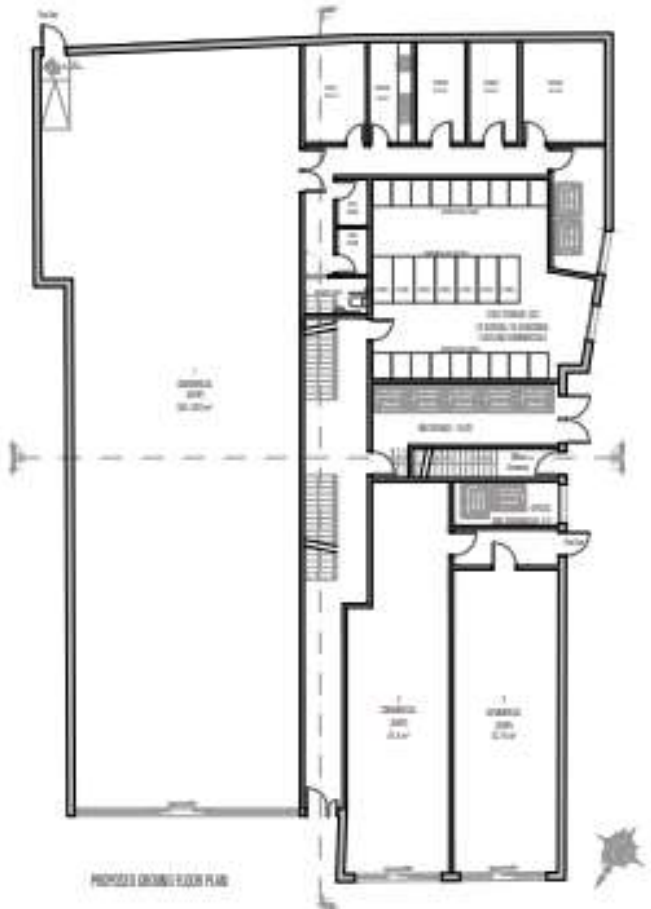

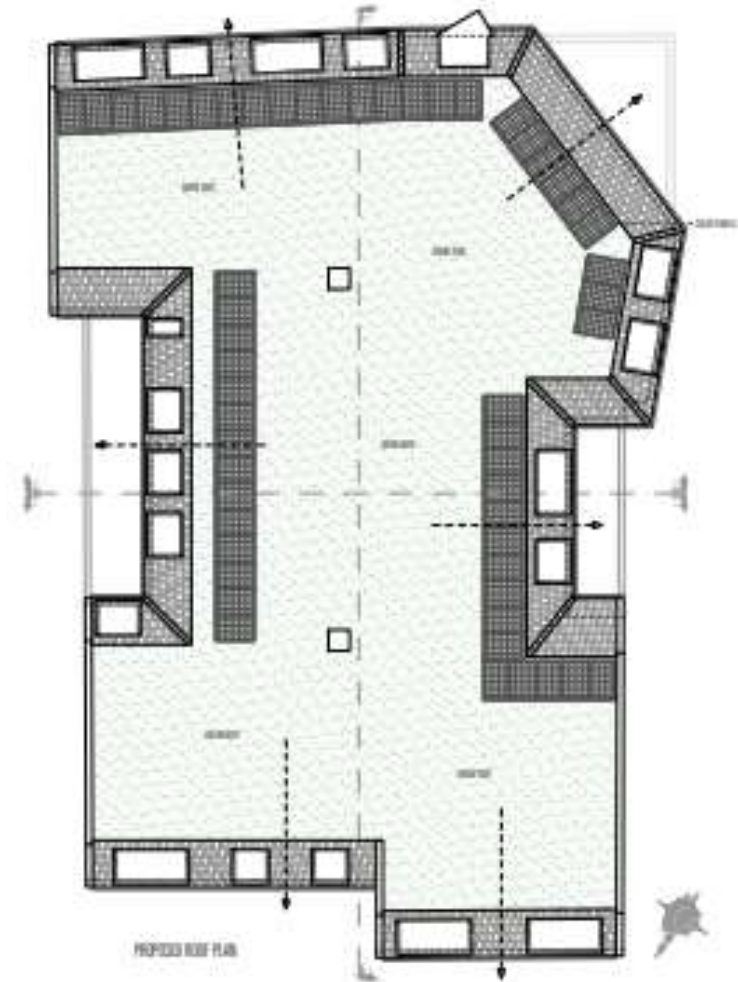
