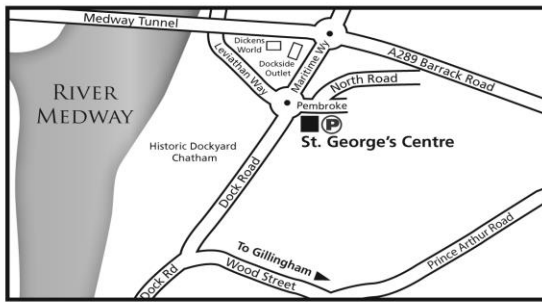

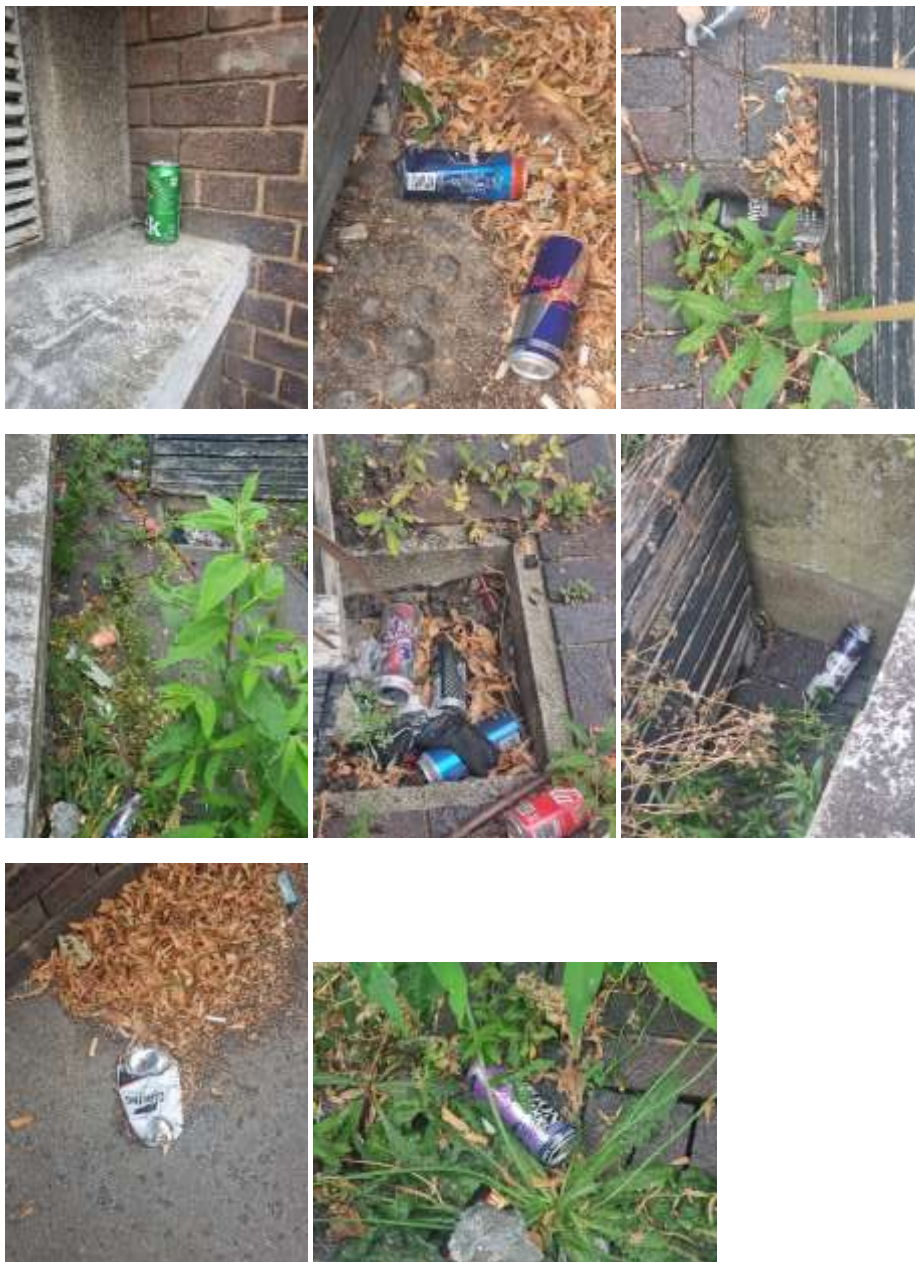

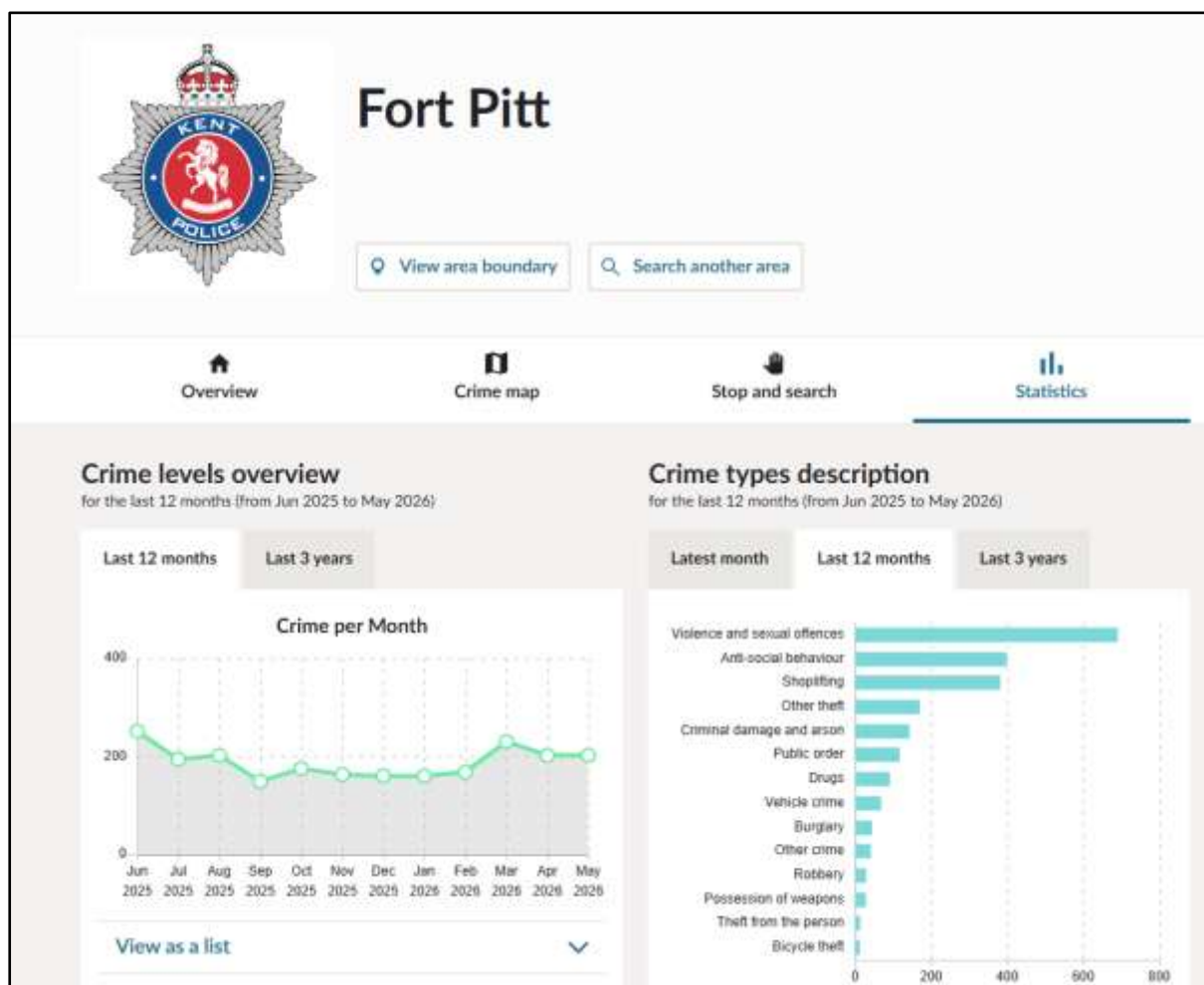


2 UPDATED ALCOHOL RELATED CRIME AND ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR DATA

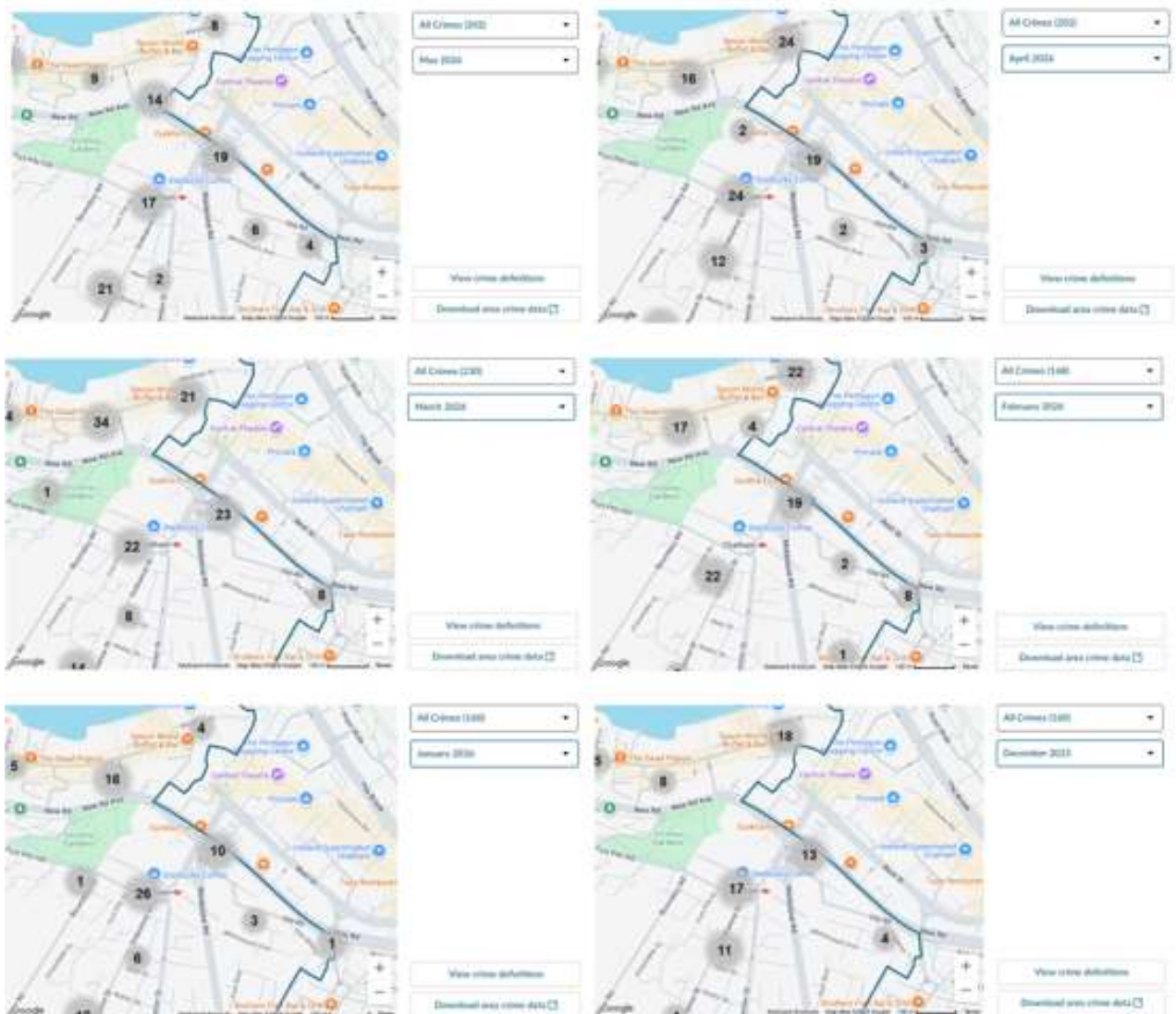
2.1 FORT PITT WARD

In Fort Pitt ward between June 2025 and May 2026 there were 693 reports of violence and sexual offences, and 401 reports of anti-social behaviour.

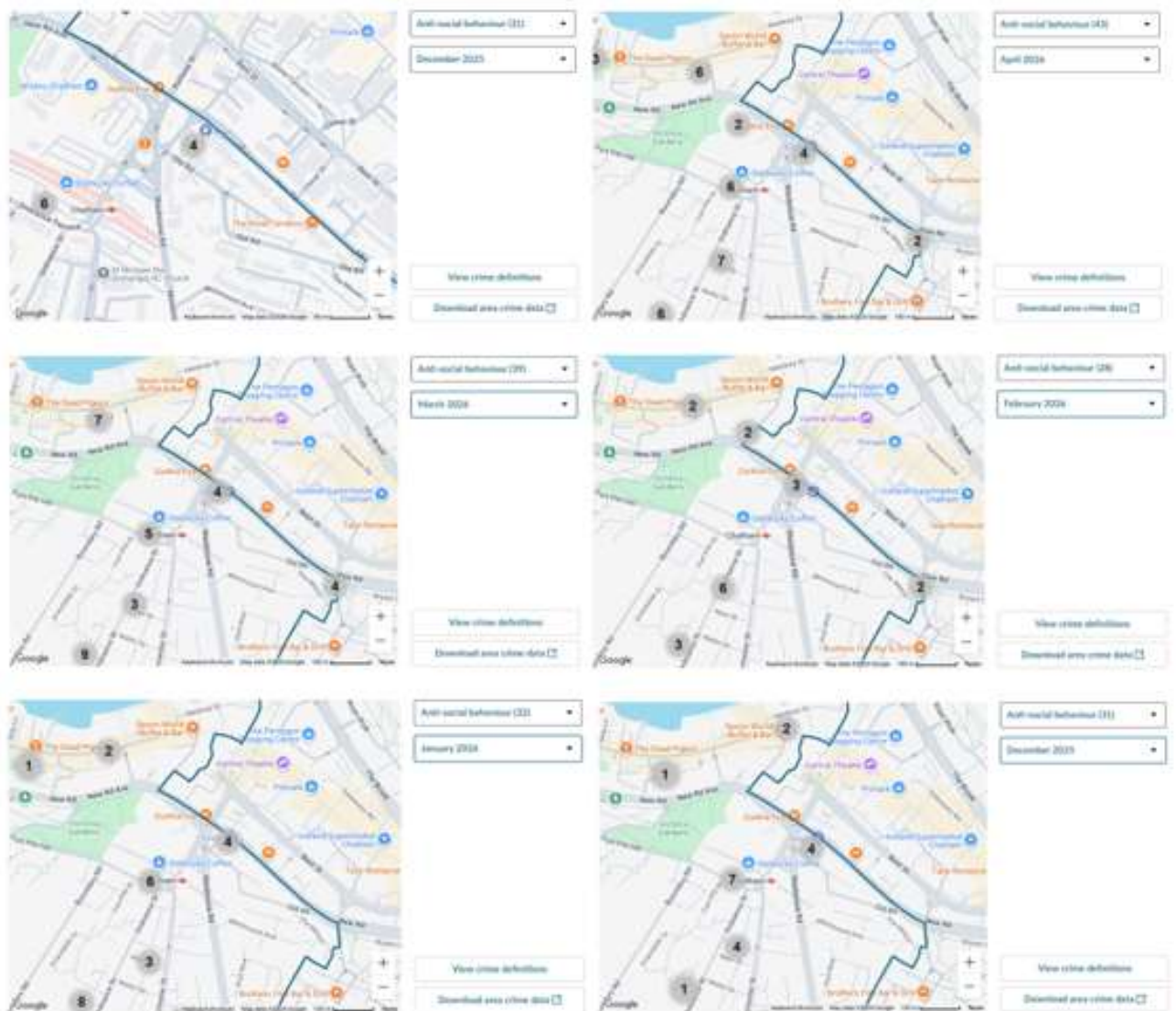

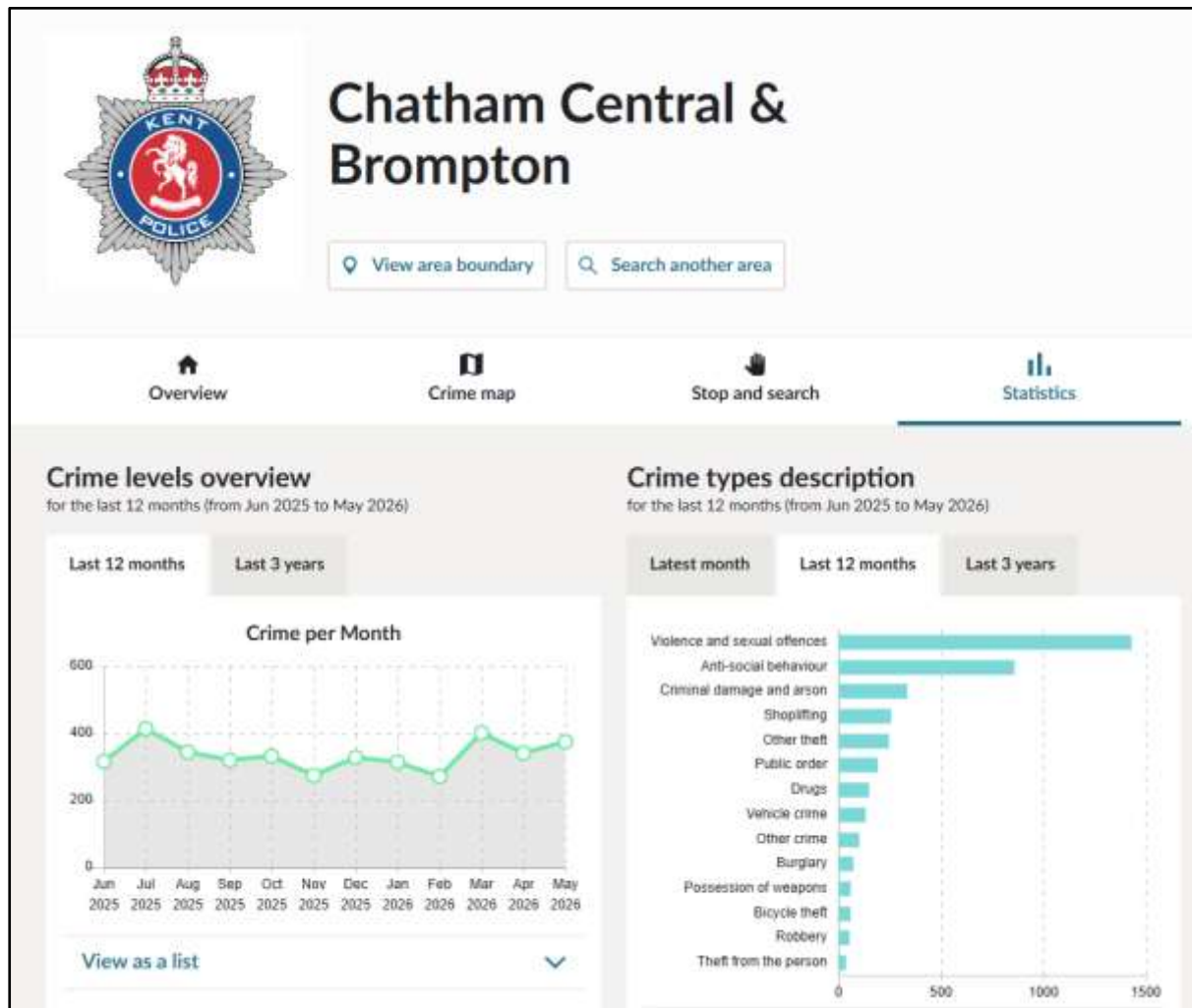
