Theft offences now includes making off without payment (previous in Fraud and forgery) and now includes blackmail (previously 'other offences' category)

Sexual offences

No longer includes exploitation or soliciting for prostitution (now in crimes against society).

Fraud and forgery

No longer exists, fraud offences are dealt with by NFIB (National Fraud Investigation Bureau) and forgery offences are now included in crimes against society.
