Summary

3. Agenda planning meeting

- 3.1 Members will be aware that Overview and Scrutiny Committees hold agenda planning meetings on a regular basis. These give officers guidance on information Members wish them to provide when scrutinising an issue.

5. Department of Health Guidance on Local Authority Health Scrutiny

5.1. Under the Local Authority (Public Health, Health and Wellbeing Boards and Health Scrutiny) Regulations 2013 the Council may review and scrutinise any matter relating to the planning, provision and operation of the health service in Medway. In carrying out health scrutiny a local authority must invite interested parties to comment and take account of any relevant information available to it, and in particular, relevant information provided to it by a local Healthwatch organisation. The Council has delegated responsibility for discharging this function to this Committee and to the Children and Young People's Overview and Scrutiny Committee as set out in the Council's Constitution.

- 5.2. In June 2014 The Department of Health published long awaited guidance to support local authorities and their partners to deliver effective health scrutiny and this has been circulated to all members of the HASC and CYP Overview and Scrutiny Committees. The DoH publication provides an up -to-date explanation and guide to implementation of the regulations under the National Health Service Act 2006 governing the local authority scrutiny function.
- 5.3. In response to the publication of the DoH guidance immediate action has been taken to alert relevant Council officers to their obligations to consult with Overview and Scrutiny. The Chief Operating Officer (and her team) at NHS Medway Clinical Commissioning Group have also been briefed via a presentation delivered by Democratic Services. The template report and associated questionnaire for responsible bodies to complete when advising Medway's Health Overview and Scrutiny Committees of any proposals under consideration for developments or variations to the health service has been revised and updated to reflect the new guidance.
- 5.4. Further work will be required on a range of issues raised in the guidance some of which can be built into the format for the training session members have requested on health scrutiny. Particular areas requiring further consideration include:
 - whether arrangements can be put in place with relevant NHS bodies and health service providers for a forward plan of potential substantial developments/variations
 - ii) arrangements to ensure that all those caught by the duty to consult Overview and Scrutiny are aware of their obligations
 - iii) establishment of mechanisms for meeting the statutory requirement to invite interested parties to submit comments to the relevant Overview and Scrutiny Committee on health matters under review/scrutiny
 - iv) consideration of ways of independently verifying information provided by relevant NHS bodes and relevant health service providers as appropriate and the role Healthwatch may play in this
 - v) establishment of arrangements for dealing with any referrals to the Committee by Healthwatch under the health scrutiny regulations

6. De-commissioning of health trainer service

6.1. Notice has just been received that there will be an item for the next meeting of this Committee from Public Health in relation to the proposal to decommission the health trainer service.
