Improvement to bus services in Rainham North

Following the reply to our petition to improve bus services in Rainham North, I write to ask if this can be looked at again as we do not feel our concerns have been fully addressed.

In our petition we made some suggestions to improve our bus services, but not exclusive. From your reply we feel the following changes would very much improve the service, increasing passenger numbers and saving Medway Council on the financial support you provide. We would like these revised suggestions listed below based on your comments reviewed by the committee as referred to in the acknowledgement letter. Our Councillor for Rainham North, Cllr Vaughan Hewett, supports these proposals.
