EXCLUSION OF PRESS AND PUBLIC

Summary

This report summarises the content of two reports which, in the opinion of the proper officer, will contain exempt information within one or more of the categories in Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972. It is a matter for the Joint Committee to determine whether the press and public should be excluded from the meeting during consideration of these documents.

1. Recommendation

1.1 The Joint Committee is required to decide whether to exclude the press and public during consideration of the following documents because consideration of this matter in public would disclose information falling within one of the descriptions of exempt information contained in Schedule 12A to the Local Government Act 1972, as specified below, and, in all the circumstances of the case, the public interest in maintaining the exemption, outweighs the public interest in disclosing the information.
