## Relocation of the Children's Social Care Services Teams

On 11 February 2014 the Cabinet considered a report that provided details of a proposal to take a lease or leases of premises and ancillary parking to relocate the Children's Social Care Services' Teams. It was further proposed that Cabinet delegate authority for the three existing Children's Social Care Services Teams' premises (at Woodlands Place Gillingham, The Redvers Centre Chatham and The Elaine Centre Strood) to be declared surplus so that they can be disposed of or let on the best terms reasonably obtainable and that Full Council makes an addition to the Capital programme to fund the moves.

This notice relates to the decision to delegate authority to the Assistant Director, Legal and Corporate Services, in consultation with the Portfolio Holder for Finance, to take a lease or leases of premises and ancillary parking to relocate the Children's Social Care Services Teams to on the best terms reasonably obtainable (decision number 43/2014).
