LIVING IN FEAR: JIGSAW PROJECT

Summary

This item will be a presentation from Colin Guest, Project Co-ordinator from MCCH, a voluntary body which has been working with a variety of organisations on a project called 'Jigsaw' to support people with learning disabilities and autism in Strood and Gillingham.

1. Budget and Policy Framework

- 1.1. The Health and Social Care Act 2012 places a duty on local authorities to establish a Health and Wellbeing Board for its area.
- 1.2. On 25 April 2013 the Council established the Board and agreed its terms of reference. This item relates to the health and wellbeing of people in the area with learning disabilities and autism so is relevant to the terms of reference for the Board.
