Summary

3. Agenda planning meeting

- The outstanding report on the outcome of discussions between Arriva and petitioners concerning bus services in Walderslade be removed from the list of outstanding reports in the light of the all Member briefing from Arriva on 19 November 2015. However, the agenda planning meeting requested that Arriva be invited to attend a meeting of this Committee in June 2016 to enable the Committee to undertake further discussions with Arriva on bus services in Medway.
