OFFICER EXECUTIVE DECISION LOCAL TRANSFORMATION PLAN FOR CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE'S MENTAL HEALTH AND WELLBEING

Delegation from Leader and Cabinet and date:	On 29 September 2015 the Cabinet considered a report setting out the requirement for Clinical Commissioning Groups (CCG), in partnership with Local Authorities, service providers, young people and families and other key stakeholders to submit a Local Transformation Plan for Children and Young People's Mental Health and Wellbeing to NHS England by 16 October 2015 and the steps that were necessary to attain sign-off and approval. The Local Transformation Plan provided a one-off assurance framework for this additional funding in 2015/2016. Thereafter, funding would be allocated to CCGs in conjunction with established annual planning rounds. The Cabinet agreed the proposal of a standalone Local Transformation Plan for Children and Young People's Mental Health and Wellbeing, reflecting Medway's unique needs and characteristics and the planned and proposed structure of supporting services. Members also noted that the formal sign off of the Transformation Plan would be by the CCG through its governance arrangements.
