		Councillor Jarrett stated that due to the length of the reply he would provide Councillor Osborne with a detailed response in writing.				
		Written response				
		In response to your question at the Council meeting on 21 January regarding expenditure on the Medway Tunnel, I can confirm that the summary of expenditure undertaken by Medway Council on the Medway Tunnel since its purchase in 2009 is £6,950,568, consisting of both revenue and capital spend.				
		In general terms, the Medway Tunnel costs around £750,000 a year to operate and maintain. The costs increased significantly in 2010-1012 as the tunnel underwent a refurbishment in its central management systems, including the replacement of its CCTV system, installation of incident detection systems and radio broadcast system. These systems are referred to as "Life saving systems" associated with a road tunnel. These systems are also monitored at the Control Centre in Strood on a 24/7 basis.
