Chatham Waterfront: Growing Places Fund

The Cabinet considered at its meeting on 12 February 2013 a report which sought approval for the addition of £2.999m to the capital programme, to deliver land assembly, flood mitigation measures and the creation of public space at the Chatham Waterfront development, funded through an interest free loan via the South East Growing Places Fund.

Part of that decision entailed the Cabinet agreeing to delegate authority to the Assistant Director of Legal and Corporate Services in consultation with the Portfolio Holder for Finance to acquire third party land in the Chatham Waterfront area
