Summary

This item advises Members of the current work programme and allows the Committee to adjust it in the light of latest priorities, issues and circumstances. It gives members the opportunity to shape and direct the Committee's activities over the year.

1. Budget and Policy Framework

1.1 Under Chapter 4, Part 5 of the Constitution – Overview and Scrutiny Rules, paragraph 21.1 (xv) General terms of reference, each overview and scrutiny committee has the responsibility for setting its own work programme.

2. Background

2.1 Appendix 1 to this report sets out the proposed work programme for the Committee during the current municipal year.

3. Agenda planning meeting

- 3.1 Members will be aware that Overview and Scrutiny Committees hold agenda planning meetings on a regular basis. These give officers guidance on information that members wish them to provide when scrutinising an issue. An agenda planning meeting took place on 20 September 2016.
- 3.2 At the meeting it was agreed to add a report on the Regional Adoption Agency to the agenda for the October meeting in order to give the Committee an opportunity to consider this as pre-decision scrutiny.
- 3.3 At the meeting it was also discussed and recommended to add Portfolio Holder for Children's Services (lead member) and the Portfolio Holder for Educational Attainment and Improvement to be added to the March 2017 meeting to be held to account.
- 3.4 The Democratic Services Officer also gave an update in relation to the Committee's task group. She explained that the Dementia Task Group was now up and running and timescales estimated this to finish around February

- 2017. Therefore, unless there was any slippage with this task group, then the Children and Young People Overview and Scrutiny Committee would be able to begin its task group work in the new year.
- 3.5 At the agenda planning meeting, the Democratic Services Officer advised the Members that the School Improvement Strategy should be removed from the work programme as instead of a strategy being developed, emphasis had been place on training and support to drive up standards. It was also recommended to programme adoption services update, which was listed as date to be determined, in for the January meeting of the committee. These changes have been reflected at Appendix 1.
- 3.6 After the pre-agenda meeting officers have had an update in respect of the Youth Justice Plan (YOT Plan). The draft YOT Plan was discussed at YOT Board on 22 September 2016 and it was agreed that all partners should have to the 30 September 2016 to make comments and additions, which would then need to be collated for officers to edit the plan as necessary. Therefore, discussion of this has been deferred to the December meeting of the Committee.

6. Implications for Looked After Children

6.1 Members should ensure they focus on outcomes for looked after children. This includes considering their physical health; their emotional health; their safeguarding; their educational attainment and progress; their hopes and aspirations for their adult lives and how looked after young people have their voices heard. We know that looked after children can be more vulnerable to sexual exploitation so particular attention should be given to this. As a corporate parent you should be a champion for looked after children and have the same high expectations of them as you would for your child, grandchild or niece/ nephew.

7. Financial and legal implications

- 7.1 There are no financial implications arising from this report.
- 7.2 Under The Local Authority (Public Health, Health and Wellbeing Boards and Health Scrutiny) Regulations 2013 the Council has power to review and scrutinise any matter relating to the planning, provision and operation of the health service in Medway. This Committee has the remit to review and scrutinise health services for children and must invite interested parties to

comment on particular matters under review or scrutiny and take into account relevant available information and in particular, relevant information provided by Healthwatch Medway. The Committee may make reports and recommendations and reports to relevant NHS bodies or health service providers. These organisations are also under a statutory obligation to consult the Committee on any proposal for a substantial development or variation of children's health services in Medway.

7.3 The Parent Governor (England) Regulations 2001 provide for the arrangements relating to the election of voting parent governor representatives to education Overview and Scrutiny Committees.
