### EXCLUSION OF PRESS AND PUBLIC

#### Summary

This report summarises the content of a report which, in the opinion of the proper officer, contain(s) exempt information within three of the categories in Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972. It is a matter for the Licensing Sub-Committee to determine whether the press and public should be excluded from the meeting during consideration of this item.

#### 1. Recommendation

- 1.1 The Licensing Sub-Committee is required to decide whether to exclude the press and public during consideration of an item because consideration of this matter in public would disclose information falling within paragraphs one, two and five of the descriptions of exempt information contained in Schedule 12A to the Local Government Act 1972, as specified below, and, in all the circumstances of the case, the public interest in maintaining the exemption, outweighs the public interest in disclosing the information.
