Title: Business Rates Relief

Delegation from Leader and Cabinet and date: The Cabinet considered a report on 17 January 2017 on business rate relief and made a number of decisions including the following:

The Cabinet agreed to delegate authority to the Chief Legal Officer, in consultation with the Portfolio Holder for Business Management, to undertake a review of the relevant legislation and existing Council policies and processes for reviews of decisions on Discretionary Rate Relief taken by officers to ensure that suitable arrangements are in place from 1 April 2017 and, subject to the advice of the Chief Legal Officer following this piece of work, that the Discretionary Rate Relief (and other reliefs specified in paragraph 5.4 of the report) decision making arrangements should conclude with a final review by the Chief Finance Officer (decision no. 164/2017 refers).
