Response to the Consultation 'Improving Urgent Stroke Services in Kent and Medway'

Delegation from Leader and Cabinet and date: The Cabinet considered a report on 10 April 2018 which set out details of the proposed response to the NHS consultation entitled 'Improving Urgent Stroke Services in Kent and Medway'. The Cabinet agreed option D (locating three hyper acute stroke units in Tunbridge Wells Hospital, Medway Maritime Hospital and William Harvey Hospital) as its response to the consultation "improving urgent stroke services in Kent and Medway" for the reasons set out in section 4 of the report (decision no. 52/2018 refers).

In addition, the Cabinet agreed to delegate authority to the Director of Children and Adults Services, in consultation with the Portfolio Holder for Adults' Services, to submit the Cabinet's response to the consultation (decision no. 53/2018 refers).
