

## LICENSING HEARING PANEL

### EXCLUSION OF PRESS AND PUBLIC

#### Summary

It is recommended that, for the reasons set out below, the Panel exclude the press and public from the meeting during the Panel's deliberations and decision-making at the end of the hearing. Point 10 of the Guidelines for Licensing Hearing Panels, printed at the front of the agenda, refers. It is also recommended that, should the Panel wish to view CCTV evidence during the hearing, the Panel exclude the press and public whilst this evidence is shown, for the reasons set out below.

It is a matter for the Panel to determine whether the press and public should be excluded from the meeting during consideration of these matters.

#### 1. Recommendation

- 1.1 The Panel is required to decide whether to exclude the press and public during the Panel's deliberations and decision making, and in the event of CCTV evidence being shown, because consideration of these matters in public would disclose information falling within one or more of the descriptions of exempt information contained in Schedule 12A to the Local Government Act 1972, as specified below, and, in all the circumstances of the case, the public interest in maintaining the exemption, outweighs the public interest in disclosing the information.
