Acquisition of a shop lease for the Smokefree Advice Centre in Chatham

Delegation from Leader and Cabinet and date:

The Cabinet considered a report on 22 November 2016 which provided details to take a new lease of the Council's Smokefree Advice Centre at 2/2A Railway Street, Chatham or other alternative premises on the best terms reasonably obtainable. "The Cabinet agreed to delegate authority to the Chief Legal Officer, in consultation with the Portfolio Holder for Resources, to take a new lease of 2/2A Railway Street, Chatham or other alternative premises (if necessary) which the Council can end no later than 31 March 2020 on the best terms reasonably obtainable" (Decision Number 137/2016 refers).
