Shared Licensing Service Between Gravesham Borough Council and Medway Council

Delegation from Leader and Cabinet and date: On 10 July 2018, the Cabinet considered a report on a Shared Licensing Service between Gravesham Borough Council and Medway Council. The Cabinet agreed to delegate authority to the Chief Legal Officer of Medway Council to enter into a legally binding contract between both local authorities setting out the detail of the arrangements for a fully shared Licensing Service (Decision No. 91/2018 refers).
