734 Conferment of Honorary Freedom to HMS Medway

Discussion:

This report provided details of a proposal to confer the honorary freedom of the borough on the Commanding Officer and Ship's Company of HMS Medway, in accordance with section 249 of the Local Government Act 1972 (as amended).

The report stated that the honorary freedom of the borough was the highest civic distinction that could be conferred upon individuals or collective bodies in recognition of outstanding service or particular civic association, ensuring the honourable perpetuation of their memory within the community.
