## **Transfer of Countryside Ranger Service to Medway Norse**

**Delegation from Leader and Cabinet and date:** On 7 March 2017 the Cabinet considered a report which recommended the disposal of the grounds maintenance depot adjacent to the Howard School Rainham, as this would save the running and maintenance costs of the building and achieve efficiencies, facilitate development and obtain capital receipt.

On 7 March 2017 the Cabinet agreed to delegate authority to the Chief Legal Officer, in consultation with the Portfolio Holder for Resources to dispose of the land as shown edged red on the plan, as set out in Appendix 1 to the Cabinet report, on the best terms reasonably obtainable (decision no. 22/2017 refers).
