Summary

The report informs Members of the outcomes of recent inspections of Medway schools carried out by the Office for Standards in Education (OfSTED).

1 **Budget and Policy Framework**

1.1 The outcomes of Medway school inspections are closely monitored within the framework of Medway Council's Children and Young People's Plan through our School Improvement Team, working with schools to raise achievement and attainment.

2. Background

2.1 The previous briefing note to Children's Services Overview and Scrutiny Committee on 12 June 2009 described the outcome of inspections published in the period up to March 2009. This report informs Members of inspections published and appearing on the OfSTED website, for the remainder of the period April 2009 to May 2010.

Update on Inspections 3.

- 3.3 At the end of May 2010 (as published by Ofsted), therefore, Medway had:
 - 5 outstanding schools –Swingate Infant and Nursery School, Twydall Infant School, Sir Joseph Williamson's Mathematical School, Rochester Grammar School, Fort Pitt Grammar School
 - 2 schools subject to notice to improve (Spinnens Acre Junior School, St Margaret's CEV Junior School)
 - 4 schools requiring special measures (The Hundred of Hoo School, Skinner Street Primary School, Gordon Junior School, Warren Wood Primary School and Language Unit)
- 3.4 This represents a change in the position reported in April 2008, where there were five outstanding schools, and three requiring a notice to improve, and one requiring special measures.
- 3.5 Schools subject to a notice to improve or requiring special measures will be re-inspected approximately one year after the original inspection and any school in special measures will be monitored regularly by OfSTED, as well as by the local authority. The authority is working intensively with these schools in order to address the improvement issues and ensure that their next inspection is successful.
- 3.6 For the six schools currently in an Ofsted category the outcomes of the last published monitoring visits show that half are making good progress since the previous visit. Local authority support for the schools is judged as at least satisfactory and good for the majority of the schools.
- 3.7 A direct comparison of the Medway inspections with the national picture for the September 2008 to July 2009 academic year is as follows:

These figures compare a relatively small sample of Medway schools with a larger national sample. For the primary phase Medway had significantly fewer schools in the outstanding group; a similar proportion of good schools and significantly more schools in the satisfactory and inadequate categories. The secondary phase figures show a greater proportion of good and outstanding judgements during the period.

3.8 A direct comparison of the national picture with Medway inspections for the period 1 September 2009 – 10 June 2010 is as follows:

In the primary phase, significantly fewer schools were judged to be good or better. With only three inspections in secondary a straight comparison with national figures has limited value; the absence of inadequate judgements includes one school removed from special measures.

4. Implications for Looked After Children

4.1 Ensuring looked after children learn, progress and achieve is a key priority in each Medway school. There is an additional report within the agenda for this committee which provides information with regard to improving attainment for looked after children.

5. Financial and legal implications

- 5.1 There are no direct financial implications forthcoming from this report. Improvements and, as needed, intervention support provided to schools as a result of the inspections will be provided from within existing Directorate budgets.
- 5.2 There are no direct legal implications arising from this report.

6. Recommendations
