EXCLUSION OF PRESS AND PUBLIC

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Summary

This report summarises the content of a report which, in the opinion of the proper officer, contain exempt information within one or more of the categories in Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972. It is a matter for the Panel to determine whether the press and public should be excluded from the meeting during consideration of these documents and also during the decision-making process.

1. Recommendation

The Panel is required to decide whether to exclude the press and public during the meeting because consideration of this matter in public would disclose information falling within one or more of the descriptions of exempt information contained in Schedule 12A to the Local Government Act 1972, as specified below, and, in all the circumstances of the case, the public interest in maintaining the exemption, outweighs the public interest in disclosing the information.
