Supermarket Premises, Britton Farm Shopping Centre, High Street, Gillingham

Delegation from Leader and Cabinet and date

On 7 February 2017, the Cabinet considered a report which provided details of the proposal to let the Britton Farm Shopping Centre supermarket premises which were likely to become vacant in the near future owing to circumstances beyond the Council's control.

The Cabinet agreed to delegate authority to the Chief Legal Officer, in consultation with the Portfolio Holder for Resources, to let the supermarket premises, at Britton Farm Shopping Centre, High Street, Gillingham, on the best terms reasonably obtainable (decision 14/2017 refers).
