EXCLUSION OF PRESS AND PUBLIC

Summary

This report recommends that the Panel exclude the press and public from the meeting during part of the meeting if required and during the Panel's deliberations and decision making.

1. Recommendation

The Panel is required to decide whether to exclude the press and public during part of the meeting if required and also during the decision-making process because consideration of these matters in public would disclose information falling within one or more of the descriptions of exempt information contained in Schedule 12A to the Local Government Act 1972, as specified below, and, in all the circumstances of the case, the public interest in maintaining the exemption, outweighs the public interest in disclosing the information.
