When regulated entertainment and background music takes place outdoors a noise management plan will be in place to review the impact of noise prior to, during and after each event.

No amplified music is to be permitted unless a noise management plan, which has been agreed with the local authority, is in place. The noise management plan shall be periodically reviewed and/or when significant changes occur in the operation, building or event type or following a complaint. We are planning on having events that incorporate car stereos or personal ear piece pieces to limit the noise. Procedures will be in place for those that do not obey or follow the guidance to ensure all plans for the event are followed. Notices shall be visible at booking, any communication as well as being prominent on site. This guidance will be clear for each event to cover matters such as shouting, car horns and car engines.

Notices shall be prominently displayed at all exits requesting patrons to respect the needs of local residents and businesses and leave the area quietly.

Prominent, clear notices shall be displayed in the area asking customers to keep the noise down and to respect the needs of local residents when using the space.

Regulated entertainment outdoors will cease no later than 22.00

A direct telephone number for the manager of the premises shall be publicly available at all times the premises are open. This telephone number is to be made available to residents in the vicinity.
