Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives:

**a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e)** (please read guidance note 10)

As a first floor venue within the Dockside Shopping Centre our operation is entertainment based and in general will only be open to patrons over the age of 18. In the case of concerts where over 14s are permitted to enter in certain situations we will ensure that full I'Ds are requested and checked prior to the sale of any alcohol. Under 18s will not be allowed access to the venue unless accompanied by a responsible adult. These conditions will also be carried out upon entry by our fully qualified SIA security personnel who will be on duty and working every night that we are open. We will have access to the shopping centre lifts through the centre's own security officers to use for our disabled customer access. This will be through the centre and not through the venue's main entrance at street level. CCTV will be in place throughout the venue and we will also be working closely with the shopping centre security on our nights of trading so will have full access to their CCTV too.

**b) The prevention of crime and disorder**

The venue will be fully operational with a full team of SIA qualified security staff who will be well versed in all aspects of public safety including fire safety, first aid and all counter-terrorism measures to ensure that they are all in place. CCTV will be in place throughout the venue and we will also be working closely with the shopping centre security on our nights of trading so will have full access to their CCTV too. Full metal detection security scanners will be used by our security staff on the nights that we are open for trade.

**c) Public safety**

The venue will be fully operational with a full team of SIA qualified security staff who will be well versed in all aspects of public safety including fire safety, first aid and all counter-terrorism measures to ensure that they are all in place. CCTV will be in place throughout the venue and we will also be working closely with the shopping centre security on our nights of trading so will have full access to their CCTV too. Full metal detection security scanners will be used by our security staff on the nights that we are open for trade.

**d) The prevention of public nuisance**

Our staff, management and security personnel will work closely with the local authorities to ensure that public order is maintained at all times. We will operate a zero tolerance policy to drugs and violence and aim to work very closely with the Police to uphold the law at all times. Upon dispersal we will provide a taxi free phone service from our reception/lobby area to help ensure the safety of our customers upon dispersal especially lone females and vulnerable individuals. Full metal detection security scanners will be used by our security staff on the nights that we are open for trade.

**e) The protection of children from harm**

As stated minors will not be permitted to enter these premises without the company of a responsible adult in their party and then again only for events that allow under 18s to be admitted. Again we will have full SIA qualified security staff on duty and CCTV will be in place throughout the venue and we will also be working closely with the centre security on our nights of trading so will have full access to their CCTV too. Full metal detection security scanners will be used by our security staff on the nights that we are open for trade.
