On 18 February 2021, the Leader, using urgency powers, agreed the proposals set out in section 3 and Appendix 1 to the report as the Council's approach to delivering the HAF funding and agreed to delegate authority to the Director of Public Health, in consultation with the Leader and the Portfolio Holder for Adults' Services, to finalise and implement these proposals. The Leader, using urgency powers, agreed to delegate authority to the Director of Public Health in consultation with the Leader and the Portfolio Holder for Adults' Services, to make minor amendments to the proposals to enable them to continue to support vulnerable children and their families in Medway, including where further Government advice is provided.
