Summary

This report advises Members of the current work programme and allows them to adjust it in the light of latest priorities, issues and circumstances and provides an opportunity to shape and direct the Committee's activities over the year.

- 1. Budget and Policy Framework
- 1.1 Under Chapter 4 Rules, paragraph 21.1 (xv) General terms of reference, each overview and scrutiny committee has the responsibility for setting its own work programme.
- 2. Background
- 2.1 The Committee's work programme for the 2021/22 municipal year is attached at Appendix 1. One of the Committee's functions is to provide guidance and leadership on the development and co-ordination of the scrutiny function for all Overview and Scrutiny Committees. Appendix 2 sets out the work programmes for the other Overview and Scrutiny Committees.
- 3. Agenda Planning Meeting
- 3.1 Members will be aware that Overview and Scrutiny Committees hold agenda planning meetings on a regular basis. These give officers guidance on information Members wish them to provide when scrutinising an issue. An agenda planning meeting took place on 8 October attended by the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Opposition Spokesperson.
- 3.2 It was agreed that the Financial Outlook 2022/23 report considered by Cabinet on 28 September be added to the agenda for this meeting, to be considered alongside the Capital and Revenue Budget Monitoring Round 1 2021/22 reports.

- 3.3 In addition, it was proposed that the follow up report on Covid-19 Recovery be removed from the list of items for the meeting scheduled for 27 January 2022 and the matter be reviewed at the next agenda planning meeting. It was suggested that, should Silver Command be reinstated, consideration be given to the need for a further report at that time. In the meantime, Covid-19 implications would continue to be referenced in reports to the Committee as required and it was suggested that there be a dedicated section for this.
