Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives:

a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 10)

It is the intention of the applicant to promote the prevention of crime & disorder, promote public safety, aid in the prevention of public nuisance and protect children from harm in a passive and pro active manor to be implemented within the work place strategy and company method statement,

Management and staff will endeavour to prevent crime and disorder via the use of passive staff surveillance and use of internal and external CCTV with visible signage to that fact. Signage will also be visible to encourage patrons to move away from the premises in a respectful manor once served. Staff will be directed to be polite and respectful and non aggressive to all patrons in all circumstances in order to maintain a clear friendly customer and staff relationship. The number of customers into the service area of the premises will be limited in order to maintain clear order and service and limit ambiguity between customers.

### c) Public safety

Clear separation of commercial procedure areas and customer service areas will be clear and physical to eliminate any cross over were public customers will be protected from hot cooking and commercial plant. All areas will be routinely cleaned and food stored and cooked to HSE and Environmental standards to omit food contamination and damage to customer health. Premises will be routinely cleared inside and immediately outside within the public realm to eliminate trip or slip hazards. Staff will be trained in the above procedures and all appropriate food hygiene certificates clearly displayed, management and staff will be kept up to date on all new relevant legislation and industry standards.

#### d) The prevention of public nuisance

Clear signage will be visible to encourage patrons to move away from the premises in a respectful manor once served to avoid unnecessary noise nuisance to local residents. Waste bins will be provided for customer waste, and all packaging where possible will be bio degradable and to the minimum needed to serve and contain the food served. There will be no TV, music or seating within the premises, which may otherwise encourage congregation of patrons. External lighting and lighting will be within planning requirements, and shutters utilised in closed areas to eliminate areas of congregation out of hours. 24 hour internal & external CCTV will be available to management crime prevention bodies to reference any individual causing public nuisance.

## e) The protection of children from harm

Children will be more than welcome in our premises with an appropriate adult, children without an appropriate adult will not be served after 20:00hrs. Children in school uniform will not be served within school hours. If required by statutory bodies frequent unaccompanied children visitors could be noted. Clear separation of commercial procedure areas and customer service areas will be clear and physical to eliminate any cross over were children will be protected from hot cooking and commercial plant. All fixtures and fittings within the public areas will be securely fixed and or appropriate to eliminate any accidental injury and regularly inspected and replaced if required to be in good order.
