Prevention of crime and disorder	Yes	I am objecting to the application for an Off-Licence for the sale of alcohol. The premises are situated in an otherwise residential area, surrounded by family homes. There are no similar premises for some distance. This makes the nature of this area unsuitable for Off-Licence sales. The proximity of the Gillingham Cumulative Impact Area, which passes along Gillingham Road, and of the Gillingham South Alcohol Stress Area, means that these premises should therefore open to greater scrutiny. The premises could become a focus for social activity as a consequence of this Off-Licence, particularly in the evenings, where the area currently has no such focus. Residents are rightly concerned about the link between alcohol consumption and crime, and Kent Police have, in other forums, highlighted the link between licensed premises and crime. The areas around Gillingham High Street have been identified as having unacceptably high rates of alcohol related crime and disorder, including anti-social behaviour, assault and arrests, alcohol related hospital admissions and ambulance callouts, among other issues. Residents are concerned about the premises becoming a focus for alcohol related crime and disorder.

Prevention of public nuisance	Yes	This is a clearly residential area dominated by family homes, occupied for the most part by families across the age range. While the premises have been used and continue to be used for a variety of trading purposes, these finish at the end of the working day. Opening the supermarket for alcohol sales will bring people to the area that otherwise would not come. I am also concerned that, if the application for an On-Licence is not granted for Gabriela's but the Off-Licence is granted for the supermarket, then the premises may be used for the purchase of alcohol which is then consumed at Gabriela's. The premises border residential homes on either side and across Napier Road and residents include the full range of age and include families with young children. Residents wish to continue their pursuit of peaceful family life and these premises will make that less easy to achieve. In addition, there are two premises within close proximity that already possess Off-Licences.
Protection of children from harm	Yes	The area is residential and there are families with children living all around. I have been told that there has been disturbance of the sleep of local children due to noise when the premises opened. The road is used by primary-aged children who attend Napier Academy which is approximately 400 yards away from the premises. I understand that passing children have already been addressed by clients of the premises who have been sitting at in the front area with one child told by a customer to take her mask off. I understand that, as a consequence, this child is now reluctant to go to the local shop. Other children, of secondary school age will also pass the premises during the proposed licensed hours, too.
Please suggest any conditions that you think could be added to the licence to remedy your representations or other suggestions you would like the Licensing Sub Committee to take into account		I do not feel that these premises are suitable for an alcohol licence. However, if one is granted, I feel an additional condition should prohibit consumption on the premises, if that is not already explicit.

I would like to object to the above application for an off licence at the above address.

I am concerned that we have far too many places selling alcohol in an area that is already plagued with antisocial alcohol related crime. There are 6 places within a few minutes walk that sell alcohol.

I would like to know who will monitor the alcohol sales between this off licence and the bar/restaurant at the same address if the bar is not issued with a licence? Is this allowed? Can bring your own customers at a restaurant buy alcohol off the same premises? And consume within the bar/restaurant Who would be responsible for monitoring this if not allowed/illegal?

The premises being on an industrial estate is not fit for purpose as I have mentioned in my objection for the bar on the same site, there is a warehouse and an industrial area where huge lorries with 40ft containers frequent. This is so dangerous for members of the public to negotiate when entering the premises.

I believe that customers may buy alcohol after they have left the bar and continue to drink it in the street, sitting on residents walls as this is what has happened in the past when the livingstone pub was at the end of the road. This will cause more stress and sleep disturbance for residents. Potentially causing more antisocial behaviour in our area that is already on the edge of the cumulative impact zone, we do not need any additional crime, public disorder or public nuisance in this already struggling area relating from alcohol.

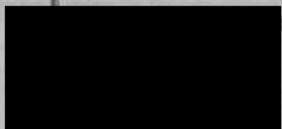
