### Summary

- 1. Budget and policy framework
- 1.1 Under Chapter 4 Rules, Part 4 paragraph 21.1 (xv) General Terms of Reference, each overview and scrutiny committee has the responsibility for setting its own work programme.
- 2. Agenda planning meeting
- 2.1 Members will be aware that Overview and Scrutiny Committees hold agenda planning meetings on a regular basis. An agenda planning meeting was held on 15 December, where the following changes to the work programme were recommended:
  - South East Coast Ambulance Service update move from January to March meeting
  - Healthy Pregnancy in Medway move from January to March meeting
  - Adult Neurodevelopmental Pathway (Autism and ADHD) add to work programme for March meeting

- 2.2 After the agenda planning meeting it was decided that the Annual Public Health Report (originally scheduled to come to this meeting) would now be submitted to the 2 April Cabinet meeting. Therefore, it is recommended that this is considered at the March meeting.
