REVIEW OF POLLING DISTRICTS AND POLLING PLACES

Summary

This report informs Members of changes required to polling districts in the light of issues arising since the General Election in May 2010 and updates them on the allocation of polling stations by the Returning Officer.

1. Budget and Policy Framework

1.1 The duty to divide Medway into polling districts is a matter which cannot be determined by Cabinet under the Local Authorities (Functions and Responsibilities) (England) Relegations 2000 (as amended).

2. Background

- 2.1 Under the Representation of the People Act 1983, the Council has a duty to divide Medway into polling districts and to designate a polling place for each district for UK Parliamentary elections. It also has to keep these arrangements under review. It is good practice to undertake the same exercise for local government elections and in doing so, every effort must be made to ensure that the polling district scheme mirrors as closely as possible that agreed for Parliamentary elections.
- 2.2 When designating polling districts:
 - (a) the Council must seek to ensure that all the electors in the Constituency have such reasonable facilities for voting as are practicable in the circumstances;
 - (b) each Parish must be in a separate polling district unless there are special circumstances that lead the Council to determine otherwise;
 - (c) the Council must designate a polling place for every polling district, unless the size or other circumstances of the polling district are

such that the situation of the polling stations does not materially affect the convenience of the electorate;

- (d) the Council must seek to ensure that so far as is reasonable and practicable, the polling places they are responsible for are accessible to all electors, including those who are disabled, and when considering the designation of a polling place, must have regard to the accessibility needs of disabled persons;
- (e) the polling place for a polling district must be within the area of the district unless special circumstances make it desirable to designate an area either wholly or partly outside of the polling district
- 2.3 A Polling Station is the actual area where the process of voting takes place, and must be located within the polling place designated for the particular polling district. This function is the responsibility of the Returning Officer.
- 2.4 Section 16 of the Electoral Administration Act 2006 introduced a number of changes to the Representation of the People Act 1983 in respect of the way in which reviews of polling districts and polling places must be undertaken. The most significant of these is that the Council must undertake a review every 4 years at a minimum.
- 2.5 The last review was reported to Council on 14 January 2010. At that time, approval was given to a scheme of Polling Districts and Polling Places only for the General Election on 6 May. A scheme is required for the Local elections (and possible AV Referendum on 5 May 2011) and this report seeks approval to such a scheme. An informal working group of Members has been established and their proposals, along with the comments of the Returning Officer are included on the individual Ward sheets in the Appendix attached to this report.

3. The review and consultation

- 3.1 The informal working group represented all the political Groups on the Council and they consulted all Ward Members on the proposals. Group Leaders were also consulted on the proposed changes. In accordance with the requirement to publish a notice of the review of polling districts/places, the proposals were posted on the Council's website on 1 November 2010. In general, the proposals are to implement arrangements to resolve comments arising from and since the General election. All the changes to polling places were proposed after site visits were undertaken by staff in electoral services who took into account a range of issues, including disabled access.
- 3.2 Appendix 1 shows the proposals. Unless highlighted, any comments received from Councillors were in favour of the Council's proposals and there were no objections.

3.3 Rather than designate specific buildings as Polling Places, it is recommended that each Polling District continue to be designated as the Polling Place for the district. This avoids having to seek Council approval each and every time a building becomes unavailable, particularly in the run-up to an election. The Returning Officer has given an undertaking that he will consult with Councillors if it becomes necessary to change any polling stations after the scheme has been agreed.

4. Financial and legal implications

- 4.1 The costs of General elections are recharged to the Ministry of Justice. The Council meets the costs of local elections. In terms of costs of premises, schools and other public buildings, only costs for the additional heating, lighting and caretaking costs can be charged; other private premises are subject to a hire cost which vary considerably. The total average cost of polling stations for a full election is in the order of £12,000. The proposals do not significantly affect the numbers of polling stations, nor election staff that would be used at an election, and therefore their costs. The proposals in this report, if approved, are likely to be cost neutral.
- 4.2 In accordance with Schedule A1 to the Representation of the People Act 1983, the Council must publish a notice of the holding of the review and must consult with the Returning Officer and publish his comments on the review. Any elector within any constituency located wholly or in part within Medway may make representation regarding the review. On completion of the review the Council must give reasons for its decisions in the review and must publish the information set out in the Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places (Parliamentary Elections) Regulations 2006.

5. Risk management

5.1 Paragraph 2.2 of the report sets out the legislation for designating polling districts and this review has taken such legislation fully into account. Therefore, it is considered that there are no risk management implications arising from the proposals.

5. Recommendations

- 5.1 Council is recommended to approve the scheme of Polling Districts and Polling Places as set out in Appendix 1, including designating each Polling District as the Polling Place in respect of Parliamentary elections and to designate the Parliamentary Polling Districts and Polling Places as the Polling Districts and Polling Places for Local Government elections.
- 5.2 To note the designation of polling stations recommended by the Returning Officer as set out in Appendix 2 to the report.
