Further incident of note since submission of initial application for review on 1st March 2022:

At approximately 10:38 on Tuesday 22nd March 2022 an intoxicated male entered Baba Food and Wine carrying an open can of Captain Morgan rum and coke where he purchased a 25cl bottle of vodka. The male exited the premises and sat on the bench opposite, outside of Burger King on High Street Gillingham. He sat next to a female that was already at the location that was street drinking, consuming a bottle of cider. Whilst sat on the bench the male opened and drank the bottle of vodka, throwing the empty bottle onto the ground and littering. Within a few minutes the male left the bench and walked away up the High Street. This is captured on both the premises and local authority CCTV.
