### Summary

This report advises Members of the current work programme and allows them to adjust it in the light of latest priorities, issues and circumstances and provides an opportunity to shape and direct the Committee's activities over the year.

- Budget and Policy Framework
- 1.1 Each Overview and Scrutiny Committee has the responsibility for setting its own work programme (Chapter 4 Rules, paragraph 21.1 (xv) General terms of reference).
- 2. Background
- 2.1 The Committee's work programme for the 2022/23 municipal year is attached at Appendix 1. One of the Committee's functions is to provide guidance and leadership on the development and co-ordination of the scrutiny function for all Overview and Scrutiny Committees. Appendix 2 sets out the work programmes for the other Overview and Scrutiny Committees.
- 3. Agenda Planning Meeting
- 3.1 Members will be aware that Overview and Scrutiny Committees hold agenda planning meetings on a regular basis. These give officers guidance on information Members wish them to provide when scrutinising an issue. An agenda planning meeting took place on 16 June attended by the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Opposition Spokesperson.
- 3.2 At the meeting, the outcome of the Committee's meeting of 10 May on the callin of two of the Cabinet decisions relating to a proposed development in Queen Street was raised. The Head of Democratic Services advised that the Assistant Director, Legal and Governance was preparing a report responding to the Committee's recommendations, for Cabinet's consideration on 26 July.

The report would also respond to the recommendation of the Children and Young People Overview and Scrutiny Committee on 8 June supporting the Business Support Overview and Scrutiny Committee's recommendations to Cabinet on the call-in.

3.3 During a discussion on the Forward Plan of forthcoming Cabinet decisions, the impact of converting sites, such as the former Debenhams' site, to residential use on business rates was raised and would be dealt with by way of a Members' briefing note.
