Summary

To set out the public questions received for this meeting.

1. Background

- 1.1. Section 9.1 of the Council Rules, as laid out in the Council's constitution, sets out the rules for the receipt of Members' questions as follows:
- 1.2. A member of the Council may ask a question with notice on matters to do with their Council responsibilities to:
 - the Leader;
 - a Member of the Cabinet;
 - the chairman of any Committee or Sub-Committee.
- 1.3. At any one meeting no Member of the Council may submit more than onequestion. The time allowed for answers to each question at Council meetings shall not exceed three minutes. If a Member who has submitted a question is unable to be present, the question will be answered in writing. There is no provision for supplementary questions.
- 1.4. The questions received for this meeting are set out in Appendix 1 in the order they were received, allowing for the rules above.
