1 Summary description of the proposed change

This is a consultation as an interim stage to the preparation of a new Local Plan, that sets planning policy for Medway. The consultation document seeks views on the vision and strategic objectives for the Local Plan, and options for land for development allocations up to 2040.

The current Local Plan was adopted in 2003 and needs to be updated to plan for sustainable development in Medway up to 2040. The consultation document does not set out new policies or preferred site allocations.

2 Summary of evidence used to support this assessment

The Local Plan draws information from a range of published data sources, and council and wider strategies and reports to identify the characteristics of Medway. This is used to identify issue and needs and set out a policy response, eg types of housing or services needed as Medway's population grows and changes.

3 What is the likely impact of the proposed change?

This is a high-level consultation that seeks input to planning for sustainable development in Medway. The consultation and engagement strategy seeks to reach a range of communities across Medway, including those are under-represented in planning consultations.

The Local Plan will seek to advance equality of opportunity, but this will be more meaningfully addressed at the draft plan stage that will follow this consultation.
