The responses for each of the areas with the following number of completed questionnaires received:

Chatham (14 responses) Gillingham (11 responses) Rochester (24 responses) Strood (9 responses)

Chatham:

- Respondents visit often, with 54% of respondents visiting the proposed Chatham Alcohol Control Zone almost every day and 31% visiting at least once a week
- During the day 39% of respondents feel safe/very safe, with 31% feeling unsafe/very unsafe
- During early evening 46% of respondents feel safe/very safe, with 38% feeling unsafe/very unsafe
- After dark 15% of respondents feel safe/very safe, with 31% feeling unsafe/very unsafe
- 93% of respondents feel that people being drunk or rowdy in the proposed Chatham Alcohol Control Zone are a very big/fairly big problem
- 39% of respondents have been affected by people being drunk and rowdy in the proposed Chatham Alcohol Control Zone in the last three years
- 92% of respondents support the continuation of the PSPO to prohibit the drinking of alcohol in the Chatham Alcohol Control Zone

Gillingham:

- Respondents visit often, with 46% of respondents visiting the proposed Gillingham Alcohol Control Zone almost every day and 27% living in the marked area on the map
- During the day 45% of respondents feel safe/very safe, with 27% feeling unsafe/very unsafe
- During early evening 45% of respondents feel safe/very safe, with 36% feeling unsafe/very unsafe
- After dark 18% of respondents feel safe/very safe, with 36% feeling unsafe/very unsafe
- 91% of respondents feel that people being drunk or rowdy in the proposed Gillingham Alcohol Control Zone are a very big/fairly big problem
- 82% of respondents have been affected by people being drunk and rowdy in the proposed Gillingham Alcohol Control Zone in the last three years
- 100% of respondents support the continuation of the PSPO to prohibit the drinking of alcohol in the Gillingham Alcohol Control Zone

Rochester:

- Respondents visit often, with 46% of respondents visiting the proposed Rochester Alcohol Control Zone almost every day and 17% living in the marked area
- During the day 88% of respondents feel safe/very safe, with 0% feeling unsafe/very unsafe
- During early evening 71% of respondents feel safe/very safe, with 17% feeling unsafe/very unsafe

Headline Summary PSPO Consultation outcomes

- After dark 42% of respondents feel safe/very safe, with 33% feeling unsafe/very unsafe
- 80% of respondents feel that people being drunk or rowdy in the proposed Rochester Alcohol Control Zone are a very big/fairly big problem
- 63% of respondents have been affected by people being drunk and rowdy in the proposed Rochester Alcohol Control Zone in the last three years
- 92% of respondents support the continuation of the PSPO to prohibit the drinking of alcohol in the Rochester Alcohol Control Zone

Strood:

- Respondents visit often, with 44% of respondents visiting the proposed Strood Alcohol Control Zone almost every day and 33% visiting at least once a month
- During the day 66% of respondents feel safe/very safe, with 22% feeling unsafe/very unsafe
- During early evening 56% of respondents feel safe/very safe, with 22% feeling unsafe/very unsafe
- After dark 22% of respondents feel safe/very safe, with 44% feeling unsafe/very unsafe
- 78% of respondents feel that people being drunk or rowdy in the proposed Strood Alcohol Control Zone are a very big/fairly big problem
- 44% of respondents have been affected by people being drunk and rowdy in the proposed Strood Alcohol Control Zone in the last three years
- 100% of respondents support the continuation of the PSPO to prohibit the drinking of alcohol in the Strood Alcohol Control Zone
