756 Exclusion of the press and public

757 Appeal against revocation of Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Driver Licence

Discussion:

The Sub-Committee considered an appeal against the revocation of a Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Driver Licence.

Decision:

After careful consideration of the written evidence and the representations made at the meeting, the sub-committee determined that the appellant should be given 6 points for a road traffic violation and 6 points for failure to comply with the Medway Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Licensing Policy in relation to reporting requirements and for driving a vehicle that was a non-wheelchair accessible vehicle.

758 Appeal against revocation and refusal to renew a Private Hire Driver Licence

Discussion:

The Sub-Committee considered an appeal against the revocation and refusal to renew a Private Hire Driver Licence.

Decision:

After careful consideration of the written evidence and oral representations made at the meeting, the Licensing Sub-Committee determined that the appellant should be given 6 points for speeding offences and 6 points for the failure to disclose speeding offences and for failure to update the DBS Update Service.

759 Appeal against penalty points issued and review of Private Hire Driver Licence

Discussion:

The Sub-Committee considered an appeal against penalty points issued and a review of the Private Hire Driver Licence.

Decision:

After careful consideration of the written evidence and oral representations made at the meeting, the Licensing Sub-Committee decided to uphold the appeal and remove the 12 penalty points that had been imposed.
