- 3.1. Appendix 1 to this report sets out the Committee's proposed work programme.
- 4. Agenda planning meeting
- 4.1. Members will be aware that Overview and Scrutiny Committees hold agenda planning meetings on a regular basis. An agenda planning meeting was held on 21 May attended by Councillor McDonald (Chairperson), Councillor Louwella Prenter (Vice-Chairperson) and Councillors Crozer and Wildey (Opposition Spokespersons).
- 4.2. The following changes to the work programme were recommended:

- Experience of Care Leaving as a Protected Characteristic addition to June. A Motion was agreed at the 18 April meeting of Full Council which requested that the report also be considered by this Committee in addition to going to the Children and Young People Overview and Scrutiny Committee, the Cabinet and Full Council.
- Primary Care Access addition to August. This will be an update on progress in implementing the Primary Care Access Task Group's recommendations.
- Medway Foundation Trust Update addition to August. Report to include Care Quality Commission (CQC) inspection findings.
- Medway and Swale Estates Plan and Healthy Living Centres move from Date TBC to August.
- NHS Community Services review and re-procurement request a briefing note for circulation to the Committee in June ahead of a report to be brought to a future meeting.
- Annual Complaints Report addition to October.
- Council Plan Performance Monitoring and Risk Register Review Q1 2024/25 addition to October.
- 4.3. Since the agenda planning meeting, the Local Plan report, that had been due to be considered by the Committee at this meeting, has been postponed from the June to the July Cabinet meeting, due to the calling of the General Election. It is therefore not possible to present the report to this meeting and the Committee is therefore requested to agree that it be added to the Work Programme for the August meeting.
