What is moving traffic enforcement?

Moving traffic enforcement is a way of managing traffic flow using static cameras to capture vehicle number plates in order to issue a Penalty Charge Notice (PCN) to motorists who do not abide by the present road restrictions.

Moving traffic enforcements help to:

- Improve road safety
- Reduce congestion and idling
- Create a safer environment for people to walk, cycle, and wheel
- Improve journey times for all road users
