- 4. Agenda planning meeting
- 4.1. Members will be aware that Overview and Scrutiny Committees hold agenda planning meetings on a regular basis. An agenda planning meeting was held on 18 September 2024 attended by Councillor McDonald (Chairperson) and Councillor Wildey (Opposition Spokesperson).

 - Attendance of the Deputy Leader it was recommended that this be deferred to the December meeting of the Committee to help provide space on the October agenda and also to fit with the adult social care theme of the December meeting.
 - Adult Social Care Complaints and Compliments Annual Report it was recommended that this be deferred to the December meeting of the Committee to help provide space on the October agenda and also to fit with the adult social care theme of the December meeting.
 - Medway Food Strategy it was requested to add this to the December meeting of the Committee.
 - Impact of immigration policies on the health and social care sector at the pre-agenda it was explained that the impact on health and adult social care services was not significant and it is therefore recommended that this be removed from the work programme.
 - Integrated Neighbourhood Teams update it is recommended to add this to the January meeting of the Committee.
 - Healthy Living Centres Update it is recommended to add this to the March meeting of the Committee.
